- Mohaumed Asaf - I.S.A. Representative on the U.P.E.I. Student Council.

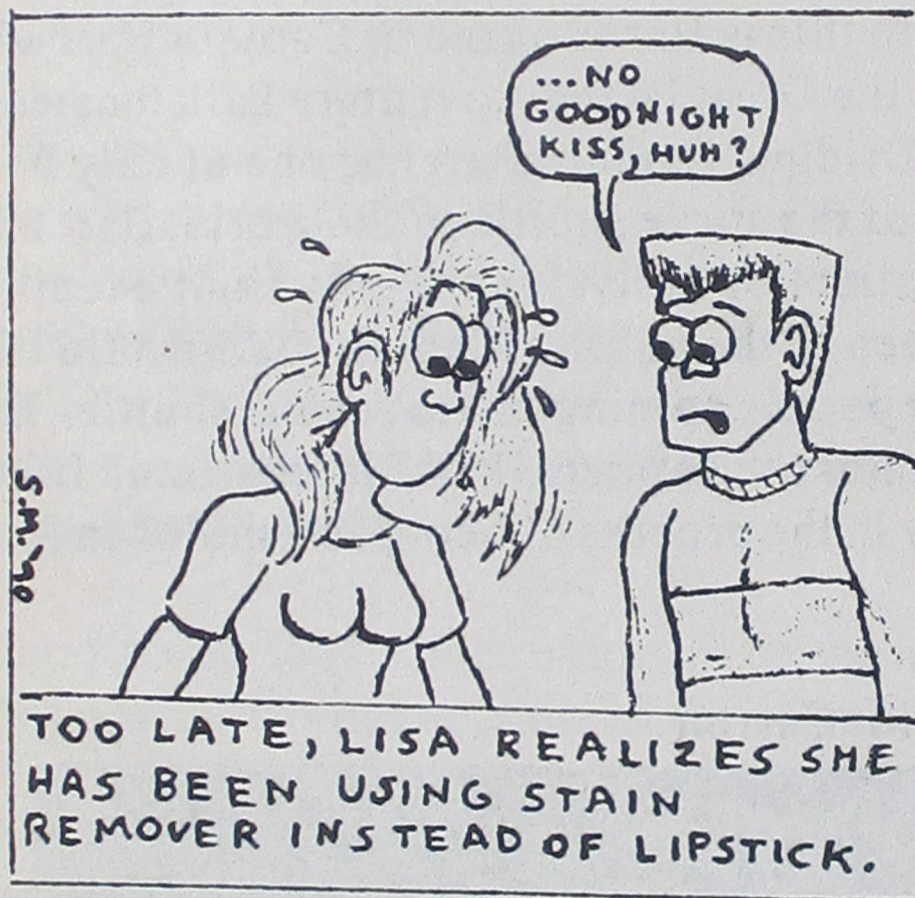
