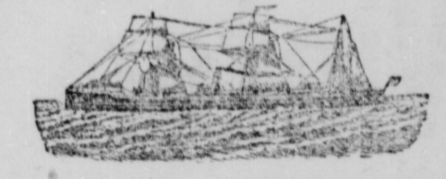

Leaving Charlottetown for Hicks's and Cranberry Wharves at 2 o'clock, p. m., returning to Charlottetown same evening.

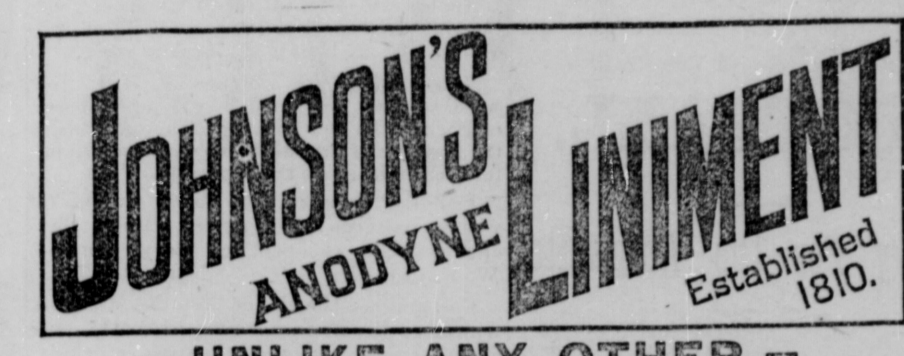
