CURRENCIES

MONTREAL (CP) - The U.S. dollar Wednesday closed at a discount of 1 1/2 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, down 1/4. Pound sterling \$2.78 1/2, down 3/4.

TORONTO

TORONTO (CP) - Fresh buying in the closing minutes Wednesday pushed the stock market to a moderate advance after nearly a whole session of slow-rising prices.

Western oils were the leaders in the late rally and their index closed with a gain of almost three points.

Calgary and Edmonton led western oils with a 1 1/4-point jump to 20 7/8. Most losses were less than 10 cents.

Uranium, golds and coppers joined base metals in an upward drive but gains among mines were smaller than in oils and industrials.

Index gains: industrials 1.83 to 405.83; golds .34 to 71.62; base metals 1.02 to 148.30; western oils 2.91 to 132.24.

MONTREAL

MONTREAL (CP) - The Montreal and Canadian Stock Exchanges Wednesday moved higher. Turnover was light in the industrials but heavy in the mine and oils.

Pipelines and some utilities led the advance. Interprovincial Pipeline rose 1 1/2 to 40 1/2, Trans-Mountain 1 1/2 to 50 and Trans-Canada a point to 25 1/2.

At the same time, Gaitneau Power gained a point at 29 1/4 and Union Gas 3 1/2 at 7 1/2.

Most other groups moved up fractionally.

Mines and oils were generally higher. In producing mines, Northspan at 3.50 and Nickel Rim at 1.30 gained 20 cents each.

Bandow doubled its value, closing at 20 with a gain of 10 1/2 cents.

The exchanges' closing average show banks up .22 at 44.86, utilities up 1.1 at 133.7, industrials up 1.2 at 229.5, combined up 1.2 at 197.6, papers off .41 at 1,021.16 and golds up .05 at 65.34.

NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP) - Oil, chemicals and steels posted some solid gains late Wednesday, putting the stock market firmly on the upside for the third straight day.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks rose \$1.20 to \$159.40 with industrials up \$2.00, rails up \$1.00 and utilities up 20 cents.

Of 1149 issues traded, highs for 1957-58 totalled 23 and lows seven.

Volume totalled 2,080,000 shares compared with 2,010,000 Tuesday.

Based on the rise in the AP average, the quoted value of stocks listed on the New York Stock Exchange rose an estimated \$1,500,000,000.

Standard Oil (New Jersey) was the most active stock, up 1/2 at 50 1/2 on 42,500 shares. Second was Servel, up 1/2 at 5 on 50,000 shares. Third was American and Foreign Power, up 1/2 at 12 1/2 on 35,700 shares.

Among Canadian issues on the New York exchange, Aluminum Ltd. and International Nickel each gained 1/2. Canadian Pacific and Dome Mines gained 1/4 each.

Among Canadian issues on the American exchange, Preston East Dome and Fargo Oils were up 1/4 each. Eureka and Richwell oils lost 1-16 each. Jupiter Oils was up 1-16.
