WINNIPEG, Feb. 28 - (CP) - Prices showed a firm tone at the close today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange, with gains sprinkled right across the board. Firmness on United States markets, a let-up of offerings and improved commercial demand were factors in the trade. Shippers picked up oats and barley, while flax received processor support. Rye attracted some American buying. Trading was dull. Export loadings totalled about 1,500,000 bushels, with Italy taking 620,000, Japan 335,000, India 300,000, the United Kingdom 250,000 and the Republic of Ireland 40,000. Prices for class two wheat and I. W. A. remained unchanged from yesterday.

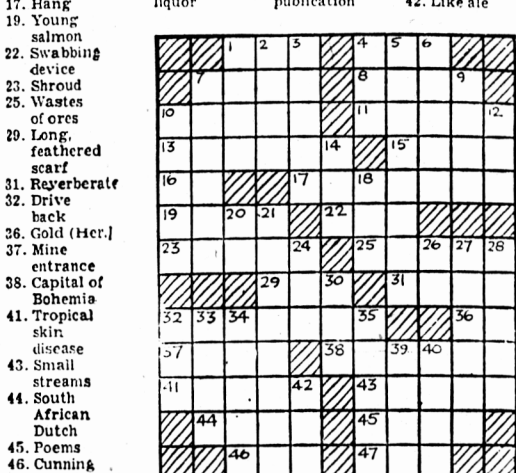
