We are here to help you with your job search, whether it be looking for part-time, summer, or full-time work. Graduating students should register with our office early, as recruiters are already setting up interviews for October.

Services offered include:
-Job Search Technique sessions

-The on-campus recruitment program which organizes employers' visits to campus by scheduling employers' recruiting dates, posting job information, sending all student applications to the employers for pre-screening purposes, and arranging the interview schedules. (A schedule will be outlined in upcoming editions.)

-Preparing for interviews and, where appropriate, arranging for practice interview program (video tape "mock") to help you polish your interview skills.

-Assistance with resume writing, cover letters to employers and application forms.

-Employment counselling.

-Career Information Centre containing corporate information

on companies, self-help booklets on resumes and interviews, and career information books on various aspects of the job hunt.

Undergraduate Students AT UPEI:

A. FIELD OF STUDY
B. QUALIFICATIONS
C. DOLLAR AMOUNT
D. DEADLINE DATE
MCDONALD'S BURSARY - MR. FRANK JOHNSTON:

A. Open

B. Applicants must be students entering their first year of study at the University of Prince Edward Island. The recipient must be an employee of McDonald's Restaurants in good standing, and they must have high achievement. Application forms are available at McDonald's or the Registrar's Office and completed forms must be returned to the Registrar's Office, not McDonald's.

C. \$500.00 (\$250.00 pre semester, non-renewable)

CAL CALLAHAN MEMORIAL BURSARY:

A. Open

B. The applicant must be a son or daughter of a person who derives principle income from pipeline construction. The student must be enrolled in first year studies at any recognized university or college in a program lead-

ing to a degree or certificate in any field.

C. \$2000.00

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND TEACHER'S FEDERATION:

A. Open

B. A student attending an accredited University who is a dependant of a PEITF member (active, retired, or deceased), who is registered for his/he final year of study. An applicant must have scholarship attainment in the previous two years of study, and have demonstrated leadership abilities. An applicant needs recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty in which he or she is studying.

C. \$1000.00

D. Sept 30

FREIDA CREEL-MAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:

A. Creative arts: music, art, drama, or writing.

B. Female persons pursuing full-time university study in creative arts, and be a resident of PEI for at least 5 of the past 10 years. The award is based on academics, then need. A transcript of academic record to date, a list of extra-curricular activities, recommendations, financial standing, and future plans information are required along with application form.

C. \$400.00

THE ELIZABETH COUSINS LARGE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:

A. Home Economics or related field

B. This scholarship is open to any student entering the Junior of Senior Year in Home Economics at the University of Prince Edward Island, or, a University of Prince Edward Island graduate who has been accepted for graduate study in Home Economics or a related field. Applicants must have a superior academic standing combined with a demonstrated concern for others.

C. \$600.00

D. Mid-October

PEI COUNCIL OF WOMEN BURSARY:

A. Open

B. This award is made annually on the recommendation of the Scholarship Committee in consultation with Marion Basha, UPEI Student Services Counsellor, to a student of mature years who is female and full-time in any year. Application forms are available at the Registrar's Office and must be returned to the Registrar's Office when completed.

C. \$100.00

D. October 15

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND ADVISORY COUNCIL ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN BURSARY FOR A FEMALE STUDENT:

A. Open

B. To be eligible applicants must meet the follow-

ing criteria:

1. registered at either Holland College or University of Prince Edward Island;

2. enrolled in a full-time program;

3. out of school for at least two full years;

4. demonstrate financial need;

5. complete the Advisory Council's application form; and,

6. applications must be post-marked no later than October 15.

C. There are two awards from the Council with maximum of \$250.00 value amounts. One award is for a Holland College student and another award is for a UPEI student.

ST. ANDREW'S SOCIETY BURSARY:

A. Open

B. St. Andrew's Society bursaries are made available through endowment funds left to the Society for the promotion of Christian education of youth. To be eligible for a bursary, candidates must be: Catholic; a resident of PEI; have a Scottish surname or be at least 50 percent of Scottish origin; and, be a full-time university student. St. Andrew's bursaries are tenable for only the first two years of university.
