MONTREAL, June 26 - (CP) - The United States dollar today closed at a discount of 2 1/2 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, down 1/16 from Wednesday's close. That is, it took \$0.97 1/2 Canadian to buy \$1 American. The pound sterling was \$2.71 1/2, down 1/4 from Wednesday.

Steel Strike Causing Growing Unemployment

steel have been lost as a result of the strike. Denver area steelworkers don't like reports they hear that President Truman is considering invoking the Taft-Hartley Act to end their strike. More than 1,500 employees of the Colorado Fuel and Iron Corp., a U. S. Steel Corp. subsidiary, voted "not to make steel under the Taft-Hartley law." The law would require them to call off their strike for 80 days if Truman should invoke the act and obtain a court injunction for such a delay. The automobile manufacturing industry, which already counts its strike-idec employees in the thousands, expects harder blows next week. Buick Motors in Flint, Mich., reported it will halt shipments of sub-assemblies to Buick-Oldsmobile-Pontiac assembly plants after tomorrow for lack of steel.

WINNIPEG, June 26 - (CP) - Coarse grain futures prices at the close today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange were somewhat irregular in moderately active trade. Further export buying in Canadian barley was indicated, with shipping interest making fair purchases. Trade reports said a cargo was sold to the continent. American interest and domestic shippers took oats. An occasional order in flax was attributed to industrial accounts. Offerings were light and in line with demand. Overnight loadings of Canadian wheat for export were: United Kingdom 1,200,000 bushels, Belgium 125,000, Eire 235,000, India 735,000, Netherlands 230,000, Chile 370,000, Japan 315,000, and Switzerland 15,000.
