WINNIPEG, (CP) - Sharp declines on United States markets Monday were reflected in nervous trade on the Winnipeg grain exchange, with all months of oats and rye, and July and October flax dropping to new seasonal lows. Increased offerings were prompted by the American weakness and included some American selling, particularly in oats and rye. Some offerings were connected with inter-market spreading. Flax received industrial support on reactions to Canadian export loadings of Canadian wheat during the week-end included; United Kingdom 280,000 bushels, Egypt 340,000, India 280,000, Japan 300,000, South Africa 370,000, Tripoli 115,000, Belgium 70,000 and The Netherlands 30,000. Prices for class two wheat, top grades, dropped 2 1/2 cents from Friday. All TWA prices declined one-eighth cent. Closing prices: Oats: May 73; July 71A; Oct. 71A. Barley: May 1.17 1/4; July 1.15 1/4; Oct. 1.14. Rye: May 1.57; July 1.57 1/2; Oct. 1.59 1/2. Flax: May 3.00; July 3.02 1/2; Oct. 3.05A.
