ROYAL COMMISSION ON THE CRIMINAL LAW RELATING TO PSYCHOPATHS

The Royal Commission on the Law of Insanity as a Defence in Criminal Cases has been appointed to inquire into and report upon the question whether the criminal law of Canada relating to the defence of insanity should be amended in any respect and, if so, in what manner and to what extent.

A public sitting of this Royal Commission will be held in the Legislative Chamber, Provincial Building, Charlottetown, commencing on June 18, 1954, at 10:00 o'clock a.m.

The Royal Commission on the Criminal Law Relating to Criminal Sexual Psychopaths has been appointed to inquire into and report upon the question whether the criminal law of Canada relating to criminal sexual psychopaths should be amended in any respect and, if so, in what manner and to what extent.

A public sitting of this Royal Commission will be held in the Legislative Chamber, Provincial Building, Charlottetown, immediately following the completion of the sitting of the Royal Commission on the Law of Insanity as a Defence in Criminal Cases.

Anyone wishing to be heard before either of these Royal Commissions should file with the Secretary on or before June 4, 1954, a written summary of proposed submissions.

MONTREAL (CP)—The U. S. dollar Friday closed at a discount of 1 1/2 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, up 1-16. It took 98 1/2 cents Canadian to buy \$1 American. Pound sterling \$2.76 9-16, down 1-16.

MONTREAL (CP)—The stock market showed a mixed pattern in slow trading Friday. Shawinigan went ahead 1 1/4 points at 47 while Canadian Car at 20 3/4 was up one point. Royal Bank slipped off 1 1/4 at 45. International Nickel posted a 7-2 point gain at 41 1-2 and International Paper, Industrial Acceptance and Bank of Toronto were each 1-2 better.

Two 1-2 point dips were recorded by Algoma Steel and Traders' Finance "A". Crown Zellerbach, St. Lawrence Corporation, Imperial Oil and Dominion Engineering were minor fractions easier.

New York Stocks

NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market demonstrated Friday its old ability to snap back from one-day reactions. With a well distributed showing of strength, the market advanced markedly to regain its previous heights around the best levels of the last 24 years.

Railroads were well out in front as a group, bolstered by a rise of 4 3/4 at 124 1-2 in Union Pacific. Steels, motors and aircrafts also participated in the rise together with oils, chemicals and a long list of other issues.

TORONTO (CP)—Stock prices closed a little higher on the market Friday.

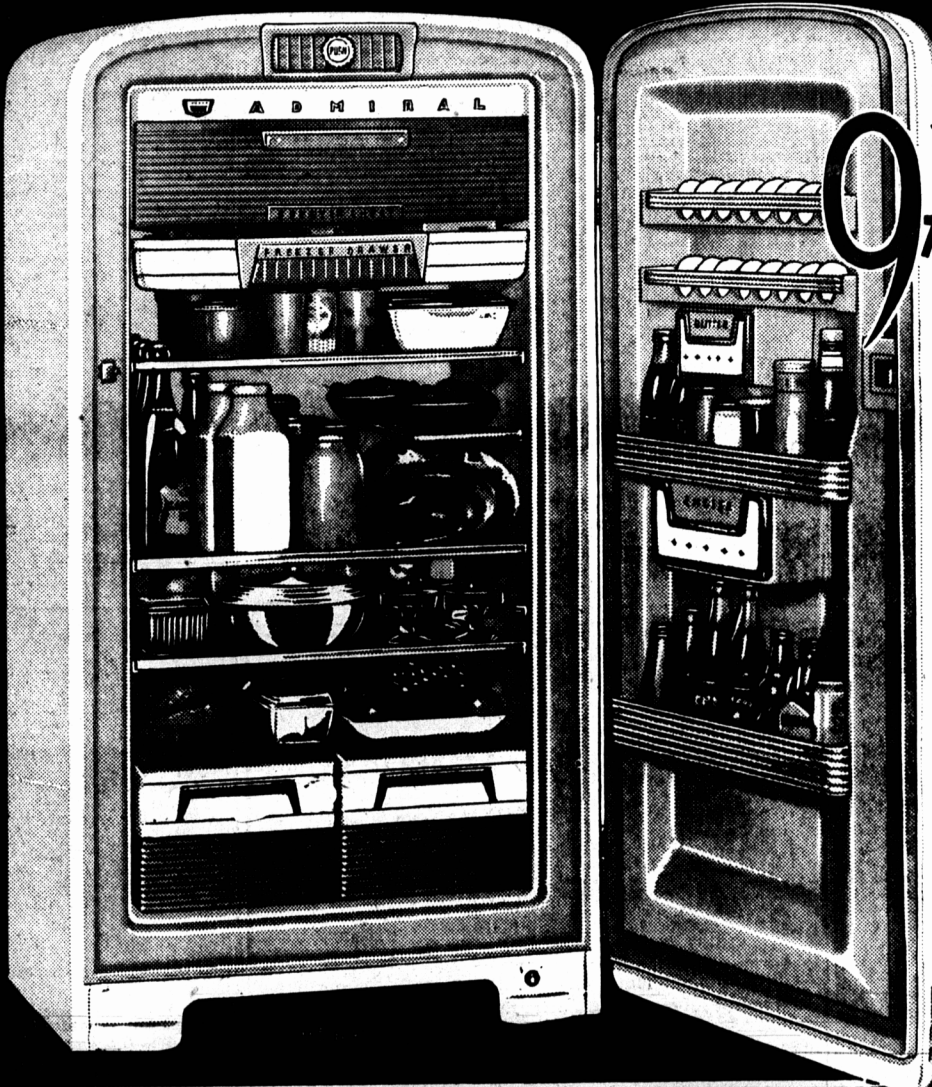
Small gains were recorded in base metals and western oils. Golds weakened as the session went on but other metal issues—Manitowadge, Bathurst groups and uranium—closed strong. Final volume was 2,300,000 shares.

Many base metal issues that made big gains Wednesday and Thursday were sold off during most of Friday's session. Both seniors and juniors, however, picked up strength toward the close. International Nickel climbed \$1.12 1-2 and Quement was up 62 1-2 cents.

LONDON (Reuters)—Yemen has protested to Britain against an alleged British invasion of an Arabian sheikhdom last week, diplomatic sources in London said Friday. The protest charged that British troops in the protectorate of Aden entered the sheikhdom "firing on the population." It said the sheikhdom has opposed a British plan for federation with eight other sheikhdoms.

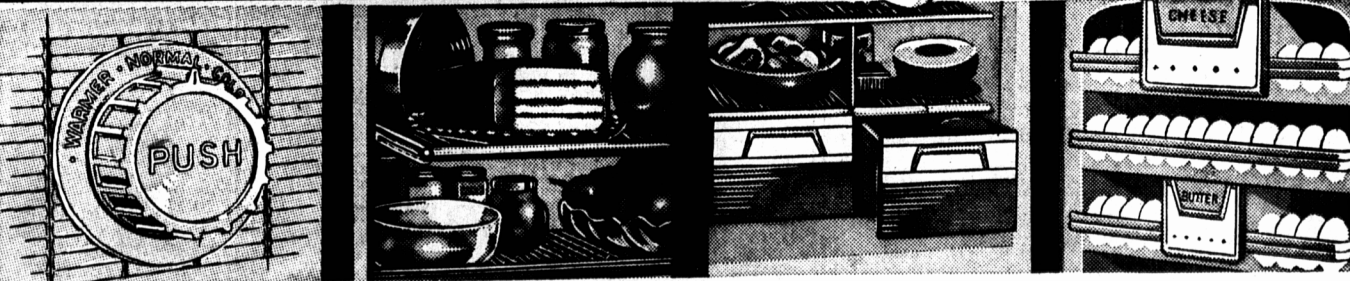

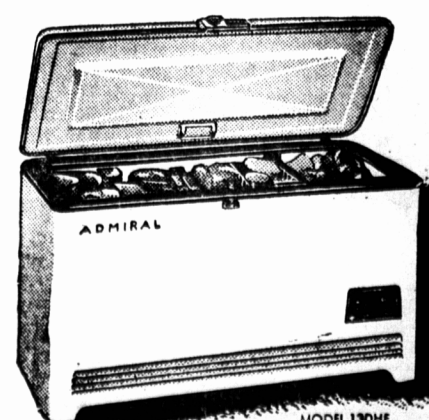
