

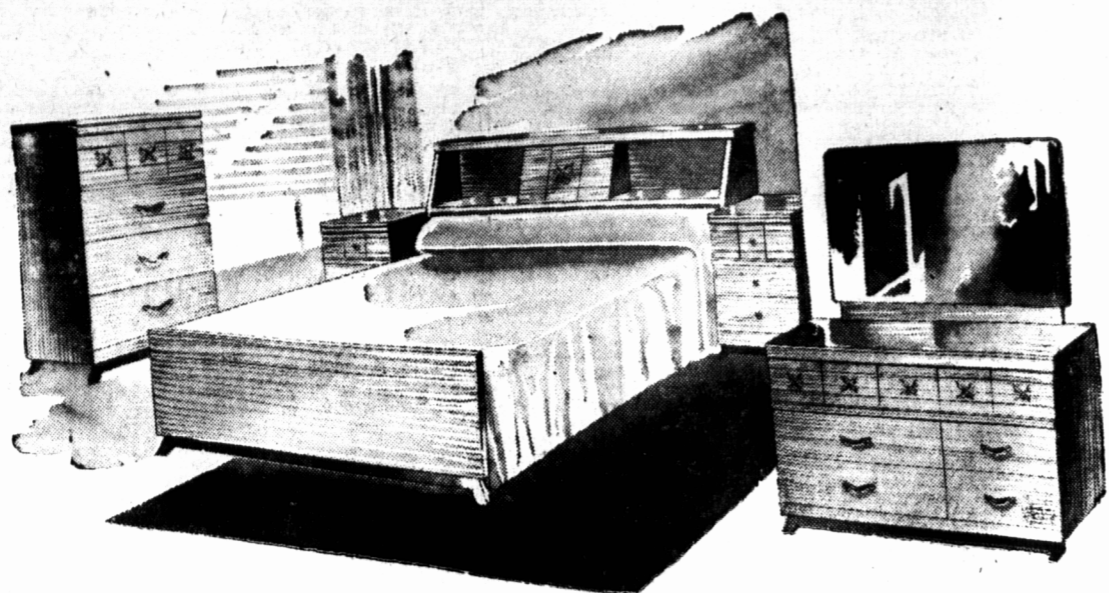

### Use Mine Hoist For Signalling

TIMMINS, Ont. (CP) — Ben Kemper, 56-year-old electrical draughtsman at McIntyre Mines, has devised a new system for signalling between mining cages and the surface.

In his home workshop, Mr. Kemper, who came from Holland 23 years ago, has developed a simplification of the electrical apparatus by which men send signal to the hoist room.

He explained that at present men in charge of cages in an elevator shaft are able to send buzzer-type signals to the hoist room only when they are stationary at a level.

At each level, he explained, there is a buzzer together with a control panel and fuses forming a four-wire circuit—together with two spare wires — running the shaft's entire length.

Mr. Kemper's system has the buzzer in the cage and uses the actual cable holding the cage to transmit all upward messages. All signals transmitted from the hoist room travel through a single wire running the shaft's length that is in constant "touch" with the cage.

**SAVES EQUIPMENT**  
Besides saving miles of wiring in the average mine shaft and doing away with control panels and buzzers at each level, the system provides for the transmission of signals though the cage may be stuck between levels — something impossible under the present set-up.

Mr. Kemper said a loud-speaker could replace the buzzer if necessary and a phone could be plugged into the circuit so that verbal messages could be transmitted.

If the cage is jammed and the cable slackens, the cable touches a switch sending a warning signal to the hoist room.

The single wire that runs the shaft's length has a special float mechanism at the bottom so that a warning impulse goes through the circuit when the water level becomes dangerous.

Mr. Kemper said present systems in mines are not likely to be replaced for some time but when they are, he hopes his system is adopted.

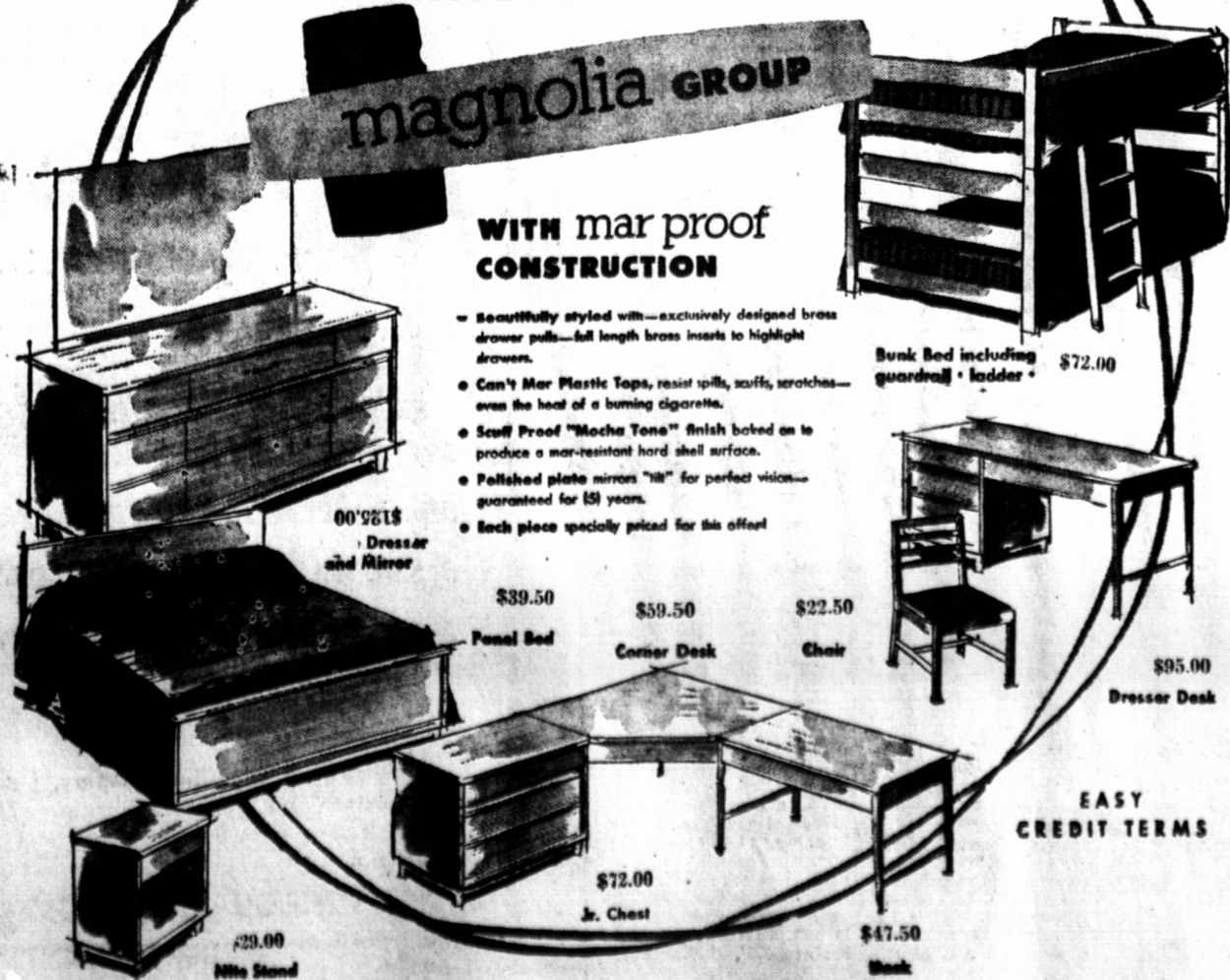
