How People Carry their Sticks—Something New in Covers.

Of these, 297 men and 77 women carried their umbrellas over their arms, with the point sticking out behind, so that those immediately following were in danger of being jabbed or less seriously, 30 men and 5 women carried their umbrellas by the handles, and swung the points behind them as they walked up the steps (all the use of the hand, the remaining passengers—25 men and 3 women—so carried their umbrellas that no harm could be done with them.
