The company, founded in 1905 is considering a change in name to McGuinness Distillers Ltd. Previous advertising was confined to trade publications.

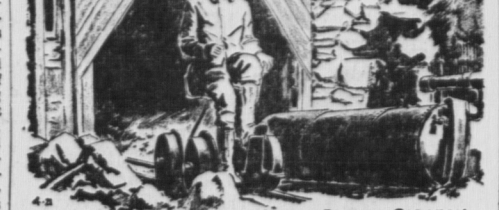

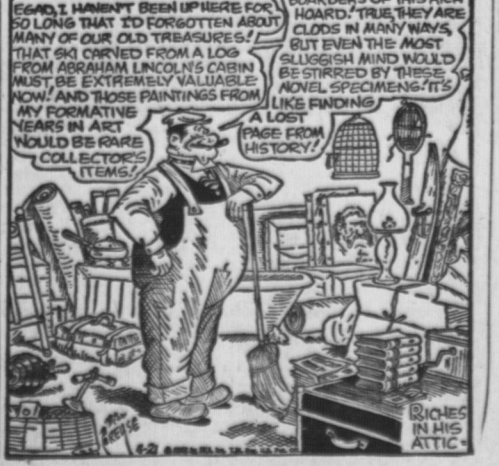
