## Stock Market At New York Hit New High Last Week

NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market last week ended its previous week's digestion of its two-week peak in the popular average.

Prices rose on every one of the five trading days except the last. The advance on average was the greatest weekly gain of 1964.

The Associated Press average of 40 stocks rose 34 to 306.55, its largest weekly advance since the week ended Dec. 7, when it gained 2.7.

Thursday marked the fifth straight daily rise in the market and put the popular market indicators to the following record peaks:

AP average, 307.4; Standard and Poor's 500-stock index, 1115. Dow Jones industrial average, 850.7.

The Dow industrials closed last week at 828.57, a substantial net gain of 11.47.

The week's rise followed two weeks of declines which came to a long-anticipated "correction" of the prolonged previous advance.

Volume was 26,706,270 shares, compared with 27,811,850 in the previous week.

**STARTS WITH ADVANCE**  
The week started with a sharp advance on Monday which was blunted toward the end, just before news was made public of disappointing dividend action by the steel industry.

The rise continued on Tuesday, with GM soft in early decline, but GM's recovery in the day as the Street turned bullish on all the motor stocks.

GM ended the week with a net gain of 2 points at 89 1/2.
