

# CHINESE STUDENTS FOOLED

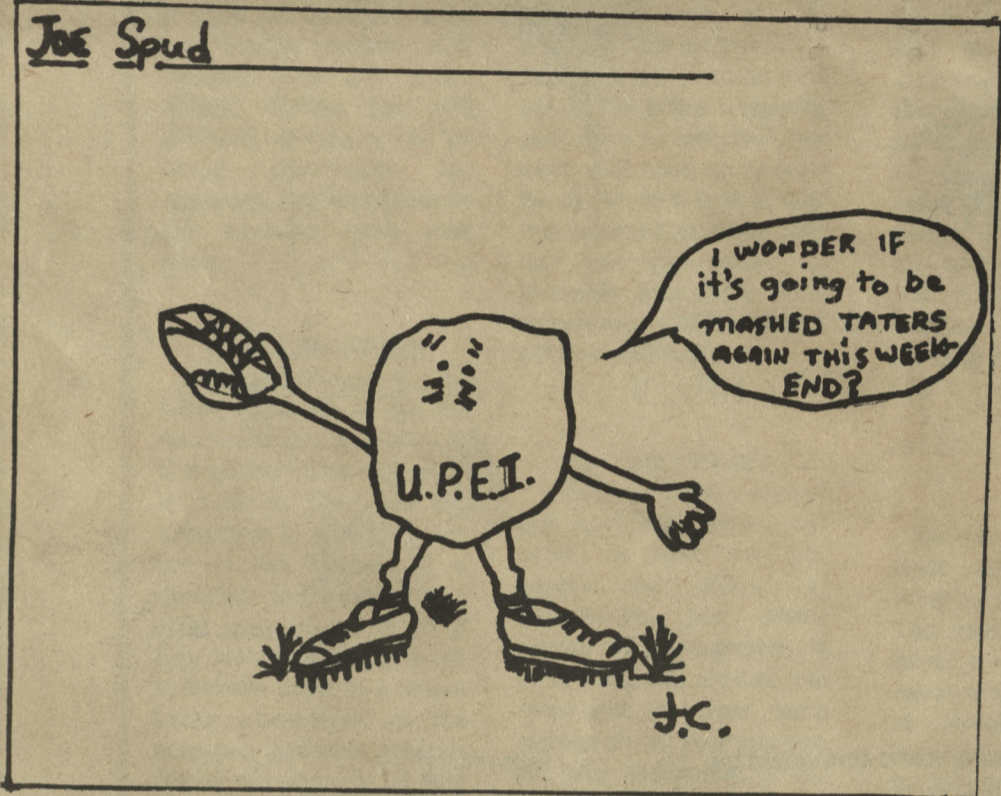

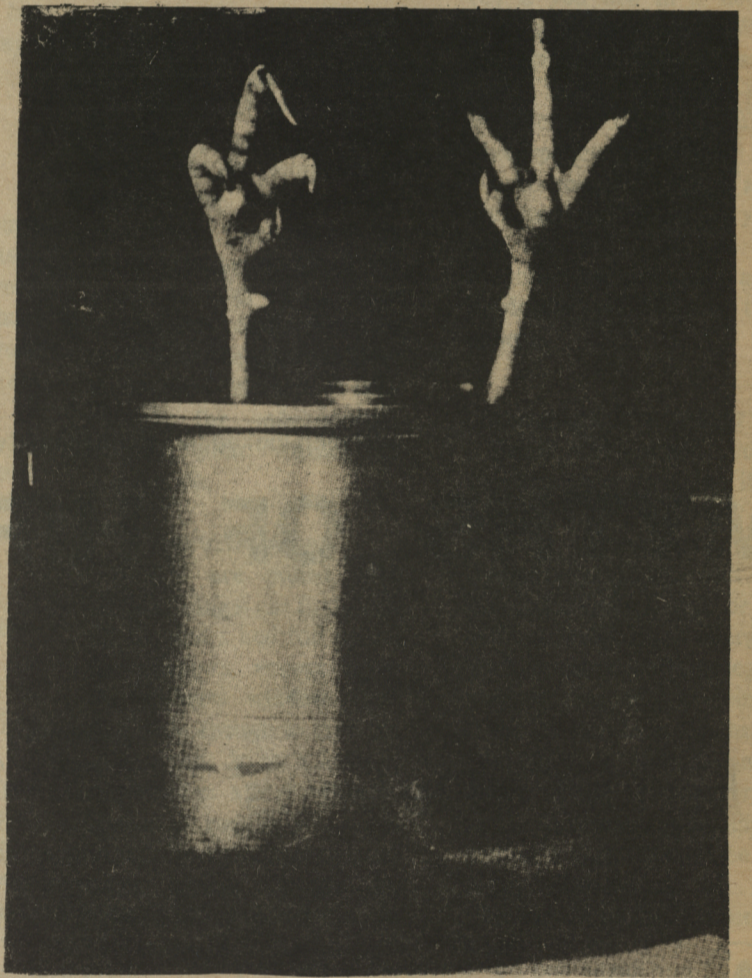
