This year's slogan for Carnival is "There's no business like snow business". Carnival buttons go on sale next Wednesday at noon in the Student Union Office. Advance sale of tickets go on at the same time. All events were sold out last year. So....if you want to be sure of getting into events, you had better buy your tickets early. We estimate that all events will be sold out by Tuesday of Carnival Week. We have tried to keep admission charges as low as possible. We are happy to report that they will be no higher than last year. The Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday night beer bashes will be \$2 each the Carnival ball \$6 a couple and Campus Cabaret, \$3 each.

Most of the other events are going to be free and these include noon hour coffee shops, movies, inter residence parties, basketball, volleyball and hockey games, car rally, fashion show, chugging, tug-of-war, races, intramural hockey, pushball, volleyball, basketball and floor hockey, disco, folk singers, pubs, suicide skate, arm wrestling, snow sculpturing, crib and chess tournaments, beauty contests, and possibly even some beer drinking.

The executive has sent a short note to all profs. requesting that no exams

be scheduled for that week. Hopefully most of them will co-operate.

Radio CIMN has agreed to run a short Carnival Information Period each evening at 6:00 p.m. all through the week. The idea behind this is to inform people on upcoming events as well as information on ticket sales. This will be an open-line show and people will be able to call in any questions they may have.
