According to the New York Herald the net bonded debt of the city of New York is \$103,290,596. As compared with other cities the debt of New York is \$84 per capita; Philadelphia, \$33; Brooklyn, \$47; Chicago, \$17; Baltimore, \$73; St. Louis, \$54; Cincinnati, \$8; and Pittsburgh \$57. The cost of government in New York, inclusive of \$6,335,130 interest on her debt, is about \$35,000,000 per year. The total valuation of New York is \$1,683,839,113.
