

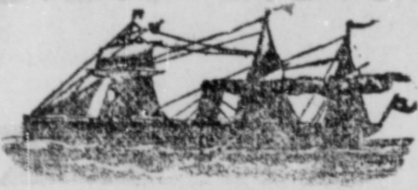

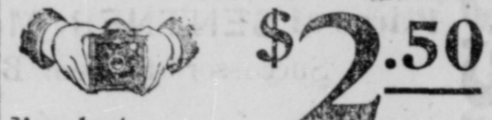

Mrs. Cynthia Conant of Springfield, Mass., who has just celebrated her hundredth birthday, is in excellent health and in conversation is bright and interesting. She saw Lafayette when he visited Boston and often tells how handsome he was and how distinguished he appeared.

The mother of the late Secretary of State Walter Q. Gresham celebrated the ninety-second anniversary of her birth in Lanesboro, Ind., not long ago. She was one of the first white children born in what is now Harrison county, Ind. She was married to Colonel Gresham 75 years ago.
