Toronto Stocks

TORONTO, (CP) — There was good interest in western oils and penny mining stocks Friday. Volume totalled 6,212,000 shares. Uranium and New Brunswick base metal prospects were mixed. The market generally was mixed as western oils and golds rose and base metals slipped. Oils added more than 1-2 points on the exchange index.

Among the uranium, Gunnar, Chimo, Rix, Nesbitt-Labine and Goldfields weakened in active trading. New Larder U, a New Brunswick issue, recovered from early losses and added 18 cents at the close in a turnover of 306,000 shares. Brunswick and a number of others weakened.

Inspiration, with interests in rare metal prospects near North Bay, Ont., also recovered part of early losses but was 15 cents down at the close. Most of the active western oils gained, including Trend, Scurry, Petrol, Pan-Western, Gridoil—up 75 cents—and Long Island.

Senior and junior golds gained. Dome added \$1.25 and Coms. Discovered added 10 cents. In base metals, losses in Steep Rock, Normetal and East Sullivan depressed the list. Dominion Asbestos, however, gained 30 cents in a turnover of 58,000 shares.

C. McRuer of the Ontario Supreme Court. The trial, expected to last four to six weeks, will begin April 7 before Mr. Justice R. W. Treleaven. Charged under the Criminal Code were Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company of Canada Limited, Dominion Rubber Co. Ltd., Dunlop Tire and Rubber Goods Limited, Gutta Percha and Rubber Limited and B. F. Goodrich Rubber Company of Canada Limited.
