'Grave Abuses' Uncovered in U.S. Securities Field

WASHINGTON (AP) — The U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission called Wednesday for new laws and sterner self-policing by the American securities industry to correct "grave abuses" it said were uncovered in its sweeping investigation of the stock market.

The report should not impugn public confidence in the securities markets, but should strengthen it as suggestions for raising standards are put into practice.

But the commission, in issuing a 1,600-page report which had been fearfully awaited by the U.S. financial community gave this reassuring conclusion: "The picture presented is not one of pervasive fraudulent activities."
