The mutilated body of a beautiful seventeen-year-old girl was found on the railroad track at Kalamazoo, Michigan.

The Rutshchids have issued the prospectus of a new Chilean loan amounting to \$9,000,000 with interest at 5 per cent. and to be issued at ninety-five.

The St. James Gazette says that an American bullock slaughtered at Depford a few days ago was found to have been suffering from pleuro-pneumonia in an aggravated form.

Owing to the Roumanian Government having seized an enormous fortune left by a Greek merchant to promote husbandry and manufactures in Greece, the Greek Minister at Roumania and all the Greek consuls and diplomats in that country have been recalled.

No reply has yet been received from the Newfoundland Government fixing the date of the proposed trade conference at Halifax. The Dominion Government some time ago asked the Newfoundland Government to "name the day," but so far this has not yet been done.

The suggestion has been made that the prosecution of Mr. Mercier should now cease. This would mean that the ex-premier should for the remainder of his life have a true bill for a grave misdemeanor registered against him in the criminal courts. The mercy of the thoughtless man is cruel.

That England is more and more becoming the constitutional and parliamentary guide to Continental Europe received additional exemplification a couple of weeks ago when at the sitting of the Austrian delegation at Bois de Forest Count Kalinsky protested against the addressing of questions to ministers without previous notice.

LONDON, Oct. 19.—The outbreak of pleuro-pneumonia among United States cattle on the steamship England, at Deptford, again postpones the free entry of United States stock to the British market, which the American Government has been strongly urging upon the new Minister of Agriculture. The decision of the Canadian Government to strengthen the cattle quarantine against the United States in the Northwest is strongly commended.

HARRIS, Ont., Oct. 19.—The main business portion of the village of Beeton, 26 miles from here, was destroyed by fire early this morning. The loss is between forty-five and sixty thousand dollars. The insurance is small and in some cases none whatever.

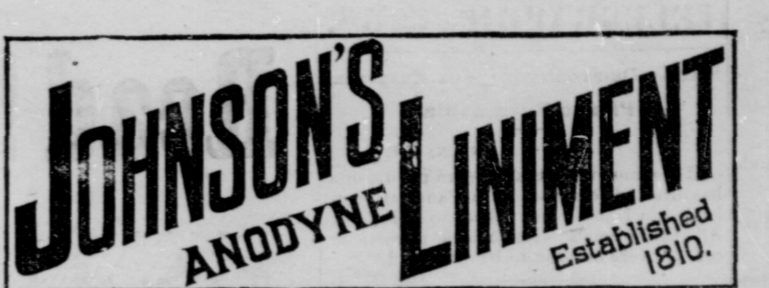
