The Chicago Inter-Ocean makes the following pertinent observation: "The visit of Premier Laurier to Australia may or may not have political significance, but in any event it is time that representatives of the two great colonies were comparing notes concerning their relations with the Mother Country."

Mr. LARKE, Canadian commercial agent in Australia, reports that there is a poor outlook for good crops in New South Wales, owing to the drought. Some of the wheat was cut for hay, and if the rain does not arrive soon there would not be enough for bread, far less for exporting. Victoria and South Australia promise better.

THE MAIL AND EMPIRE remarks that of manufactures of iron and steel we imported in August \$3,150,000 worth from the United States and \$520,000 from Great Britain. Comparisons of this kind open the eyes of the Mother-Country to the hoax that has been perpetrated on her by the "preference."

IN THE PHILLIPINES.

Close Call for a Transport—Hard March for Troops.

SEATTLE, Wash., Dec. 15.—Letters have been received announcing the grounding of the transport Garonne on the coast of Northern Luzon. She struck twice, being rescued both times by the Yorktown. The Yorktown used a two-inch wire cable to pull her off, and the second time the cable caught in the Garonne's wheel causing a further delay of twelve hours. The letter also tells about a hard march of the American troops under Gen. Hall. The line of march was over steep mountains for a distance of 45 miles, taking in all six days, at the conclusion of which 165 men were under medical treatment for several days.
