Sukarno Names New Army Chief

KUALA LUMPUR, Malaysia (AP)—President Sukarno of Indonesia has named a new army commander—Maj.-Gen. Suharto who smashed the pro-Communist coup Sept. 30.
Suharto, who appears to be emerging as a strongman, succeeds Maj.-Gen. Achmad Yani, who was slain by the pro-Communist rebels.
Sukarno, in statements made to the official news agency Antara and broadcast by Radio Jakarta, noted that since Yani's slaying he has been in full control of the army.
The appointment confirmed Suharto's rise to power since the coup attempt.
Sukarno removed Gen. Pranoto Reksosamudro, known to be leftist-inclined, from the top army post to which he had been named temporarily by the president shortly after the coup's collapse.
SILENT ON NASUTION
The Jakarta broadcast made no mention of Gen. Abdul Haris Nasution, Sukarno's defence minister and armed forces commander, who presumably continues to occupy his positions.
Diplomatic sources in Kuala Lumpur and Singapore, who know the Indonesian situation, have rated Dutch-trained Suharto as a good soldier and possibly the only commander with enough backing at present to fight and beat the Communists.
Suharto, in his mid-40s, compares with Pranoto, whom, diplomatic sources said, was first chosen by Sukarno as army chief immediately after the coup because he was "fully acceptable to the PKI," the Indonesian Communist party.

Suharto has been in the forefront of the army's anti-Communist campaign since it flared with the discovery of the bodies of six top army generals, including Yani's, Oct. 4. They had been apparently tortured by the rebels before death.
FOUGHT REBELS
Sukarno had appointed Suharto to direct the campaign against the rebels in his Oct. 3 message to the country, in which he named Pranoto acting army chief.
This had seemed a demotion for Suharto at the time, but his name was repeatedly mentioned in Jakarta reports, particularly in connection with the army's anti-Communist crackdown.

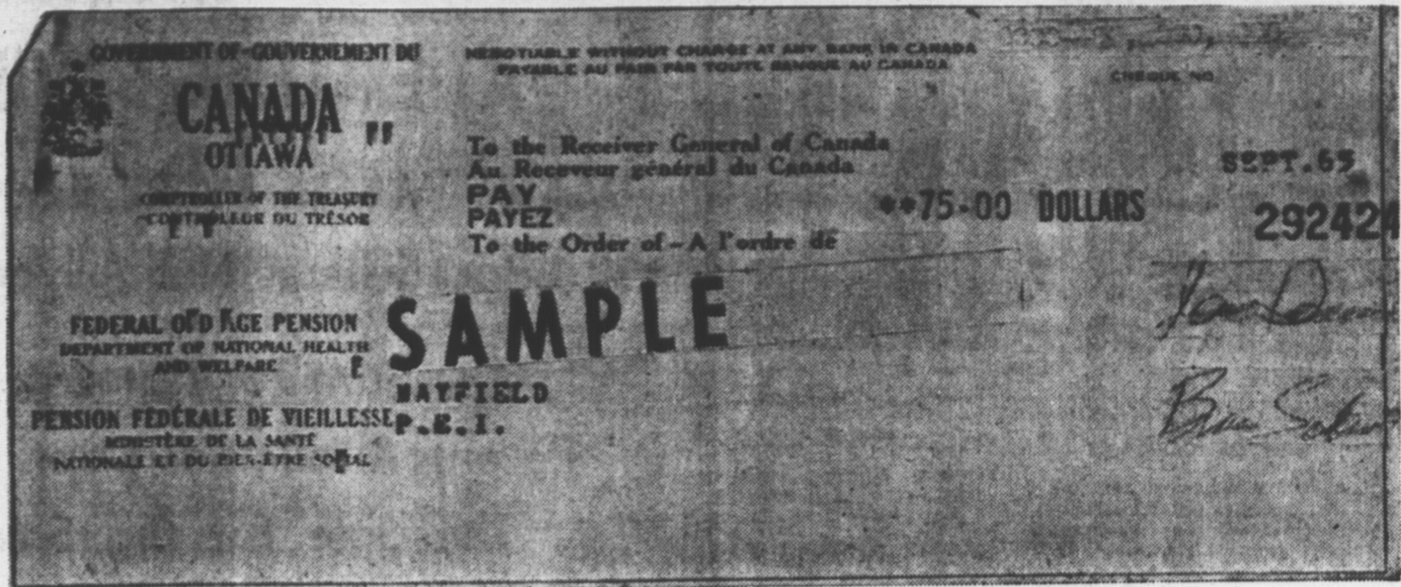

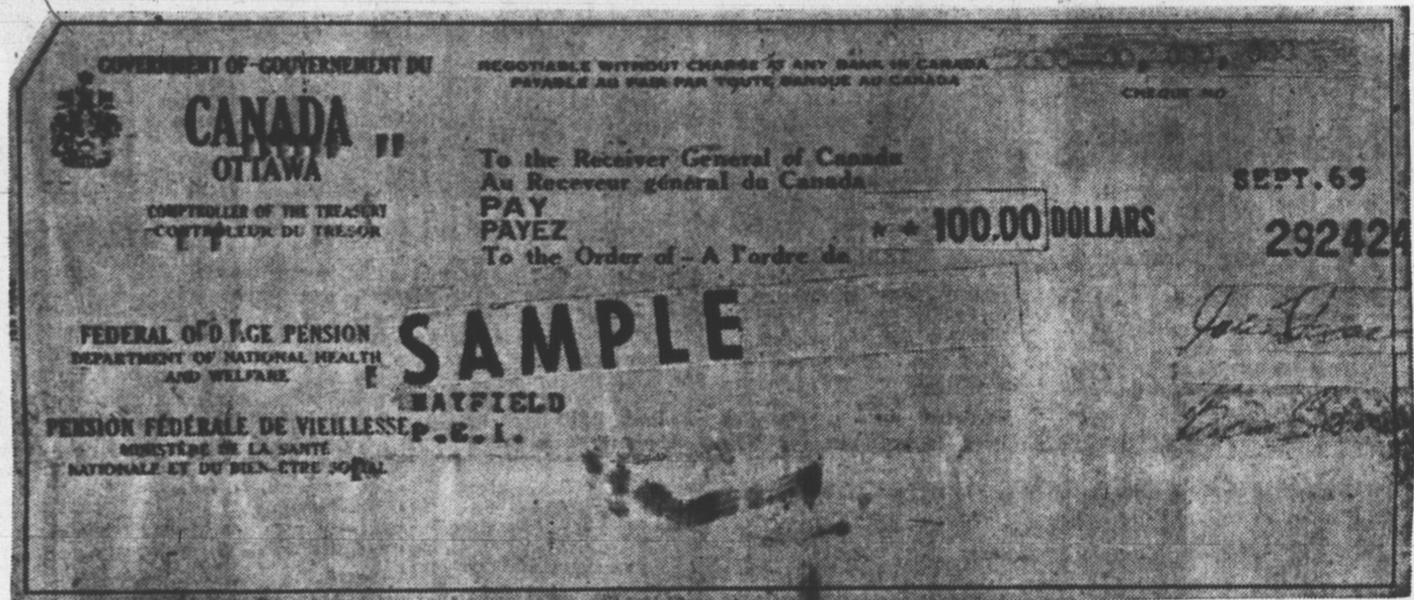
