Deadline February 1, 1980

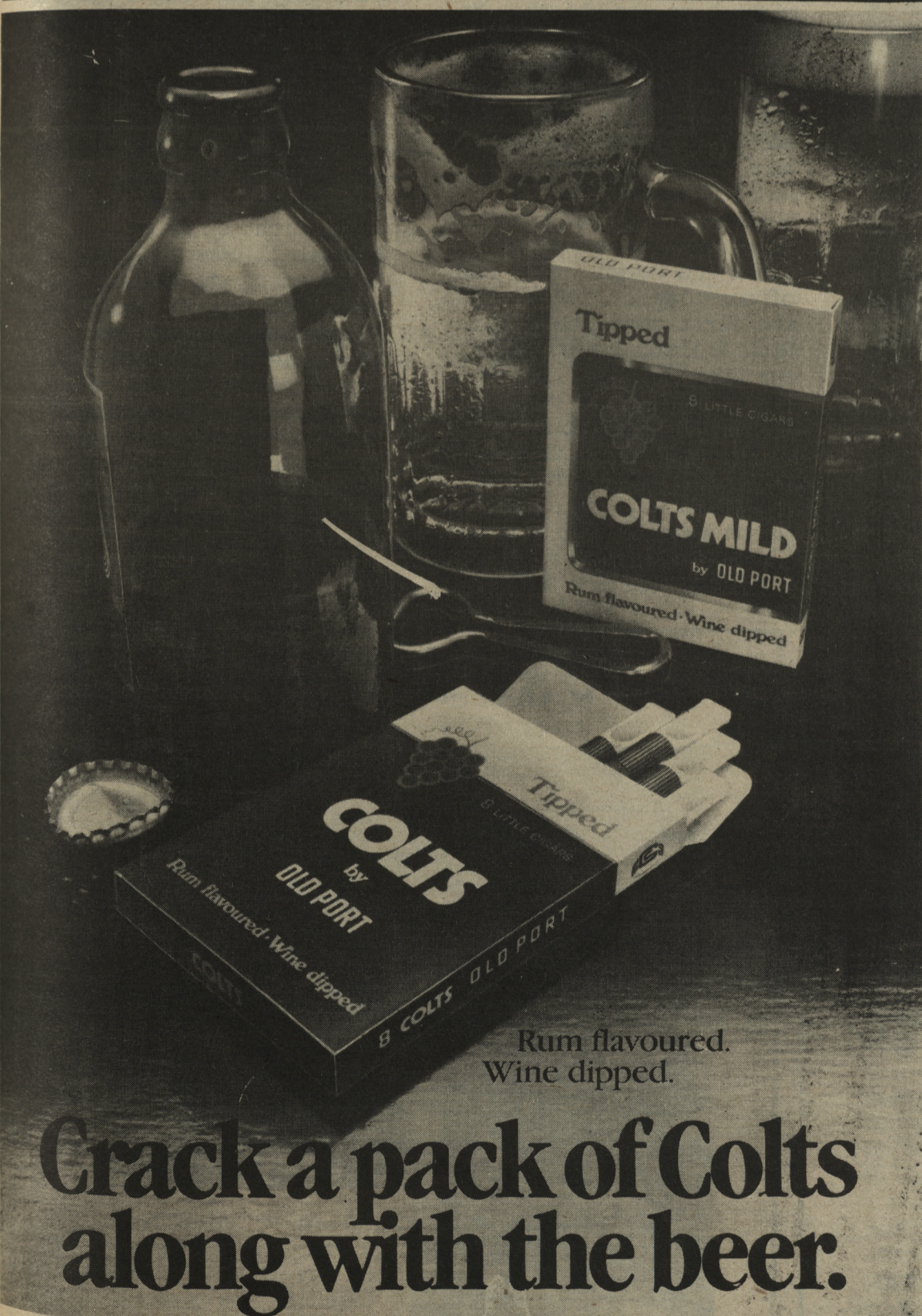
U.P.E.I. Memorial bursary fund
