Terrorism, spread through the country-side in the wake of the country's revolution, has driven hundreds of thousands to seek the safety of the city with the result that its population now is between 2,700,000 and 3,000,000 as compared with 600,000 in 1940.

Police estimate that no fewer than 100,000 of the Indonesia capital's post-war inhabitants are without housing.

And the others are crowded, sometimes one or two families in a single room, in dwellings increasingly in need of repairs which are unlikely to be carried out in a foreseeable future.

All dwellings are under the direct control of the housing author-

ity and no one who vacates his living space for longer than a short holiday has the slightest hope of finding it available on his return.

With the overcrowding have come the usual post-war difficulties of high prices and shortages, but in accentuated form.

State of Disrepair

Labor for any building not officially blessed by the housing authority is at a premium, and so are the materials. A Dutch acquaintance told me that it would have cost him \$224 to replace the broken windows in his three bedrooms.

Like many others, he must depend on the protection of shutters

for an open window at night is an invitation to the thousands of petty thieves who add to the difficulties of life here today.

The visitor to Jakarta is struck

by the all-prevailing state of disrepair. Dwellings and business places alike are provided with wash basins, taps and flush toilets.

But these are only a memory of

better times, for 99 out of every 100 such plumbing gadgets today are out of commission — and unlikely to function again in the near future.
