NEW YORK (AP) - The stock market Wednesday made its best rally in nearly five weeks in a technical recovery from a long series of sharp losses.

Automotive stocks were the pacemakers and once again American Motors was the most active stock, reaching another high.

The AP 60-stock average fell \$21.80 from Aug. 3 to Tuesday's close but Wednesday it rose \$2.40 to \$216.40 for its best jump since Aug. 20 when it rose \$3.

A feature of the day was a leap of 2 1/2% by Gulf Oil following news of its proposal for a 3-for-1 stock split and a higher dividend.

American Motors rose 2 1/2% to 55 1/2 on 126,900 shares. Among better seasoned issues, U.S. Steel gained 1/4, American Telephone 1, General Motors 1/4 and Du Pont 3/4.

Among Canadian issues, Aluminum Ltd., gained 1/2. Distillers Seagrams 2, Canadian Pacific 3/4, Granby Mining 1/4, Hudson Bay Mining 1/4 and International Nickel 1/4. Dome Mines lost 1/4 and McIntyre Porcupine 1/4.

American Stock Exchange prices advanced on volume of 940,000 shares. Fairchild Camera rose 2 1/4, U.S. Foll B 1/4 and Rath Packing 1/4.

MONTREAL: MONTREAL (CP) - Closing prices Wednesday showed a sharp upward movement on the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges. Advances outnumbered declines by more than 2 to 1.

TORONTO (CP) - Base metals climbed better than two points in moderate trading on the stock market Wednesday. West-ern oils added more than three-quarters. Golds, the lone losers, were off a few decimal points.

Orchard was the most active speculative mine, up 15 cents at 95 cents. Senior base metals started slow but gathered strength in afternoon trade. International Nickel, Noranda, Consolidated Mining and Labrador was up 1/2.

Changes in golds were generally limited to juniors, moving in a few penny range. Hollinger added 1/2 at 28 1/2 but Kerr-Ad-dison dipped 1/4 at 19 1/2.

Pacific Petroleum added 1/2 at 11 1/2 to lead western oils. Bailey Sel-burn was up 25 cents but Calgary and Edmonton was down 1/4 at 20 1/2. Home B and Hudson's Bay were off 1/4.

Index changes: golds off .10 to 84.1; base metals up .18 to 159.73; western oils up .88 to 102.0.
