

Glut Of Used Automobiles Is Boosting Trade-In Costs

TORONTO (CP)—The Globe and Mail says the cost of trading in a car on a new one has risen by up to \$200 for most Canadians in the last two months because of a glut of used autos.

There has been no change in the factory price of new cars but used-car values have been slashed, it says.

The newspaper says Toronto dealers, who see the pattern for Canadian auto prices, admit the value of used cars is between \$100 and \$200 lower than normal for this time of year.

It quotes dealers as saying cars of the 1962-65 vintage have declined most in value because of formerly leased autos have been dumped on the market.

SAY CUT PROFITS

The majority of dealers, it says, insist their new-car customers are not paying more money on an over-all deal because they are shaving profits to meet competition and most dealers said business is starting to pick up after the Christmas slow-down.

The newspaper says National Automotive Publishers Ltd., which publishes a list of used-car valuations six times a year, revealed in its latest issue that used cars dropped the normal \$150 in value as a result of the October changeover to new models. But because of the excessive supply of second-hand vehicles many dealers were chopping another \$100 to \$200 from trade-in allowances.

The list, known as the Red Book, is compiled in co-operation with dealers belonging to the Federation of Automobile Dealers-Associations of Canada. But the story adds that most dealers say they use the list as a guide rather than a rule book.

U.S. Steel Price Trend Is Question

CLEVELAND, Ohio (AP)—The price trend in the coming months is the big question in the steel industry, Steel Magazine reports.

The magazine says a general steel price upturn in the future seems unlikely, but selective increases such as those last week on structural steel are possible from time to time.

Steel inventories are being eliminated faster than expected, confirming steelmakers' views on the liquidation of stock piles, the magazine says.

Also noted is increased military demand "indicating heavy defence buying is ahead."

"One big steelmaker is understood to have booked a \$10,000,000 bomb contract," Steel says.

"At the same time, orders are being placed for hundreds of tons of heavy, rough-machined, billet stock forgings for artillery."

The magazine notes that construction, railways, railway equipment, earthmoving machinery and automotive industries still are the most active consumers.

Steel says ingot production recovered from the holiday dip, with output in the week ended Jan. 7 estimated at 2,224,000 net tons, compared with 2,185,000 tons the week before and 2,656,000 in the corresponding week last year.

MAIL MYSTERY IS SOLVED

CASSANO D'ADDA, Italy (AP)—A mystery about missing Christmas cards was solved here today. Mailman Antonio Carliotti, 56, was accused of dumping the cards in a canal because he got tired of carrying them.

"There was too much work," police quoted him as saying.

"I had been working like a mule during the Christmas period. I did my best to deliver the important letters and parcels in due time. But, gentlemen, let's try to be sensible. Those damned postcards are certainly not very important things. So I threw the lot into the canal. I certainly never thought there would be somebody with the hobby of letter-fishing."

Investigation began last week when residents along Carliotti's delivery route in this north Italian town grew alarmed at the sight of mail floating in a canal.

Carliotti was suspended from service and formally charged with destroying mail.

Harriman Tour Is Continued

CANBERRA (Reuters)—W. Averell Harriman, President Johnson's special envoy on Viet Nam peace plans, arrived here by plane Sunday for talks with Australian Prime Minister Menzies.

Harriman told reporters at the airport that Johnson remains determined not to let South Viet Nam be taken over by force, but that in all other aspects of possible peace talks the U.S. president is flexible.

Harriman said he found that people in the eight countries he has visited so far are ready to accept Johnson's sincerity.

PLAN TO END STRIKE

TORONTO (CP)—The Canadian Labor Congress announced Friday it is planning a labor-management conference in an effort to end the 18-month strike by Toronto newspaper printers and mailers. The meeting will attempt to establish means of re-opening negotiations with publishers and the union. More than 900 workers struck the three Toronto papers July 9, 1964. The main issue in the strike is automation.
