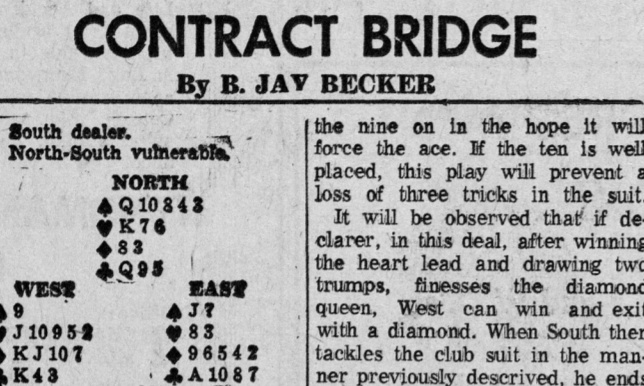

One-In-A-Lifetime Benefit Conferred Under The Budget

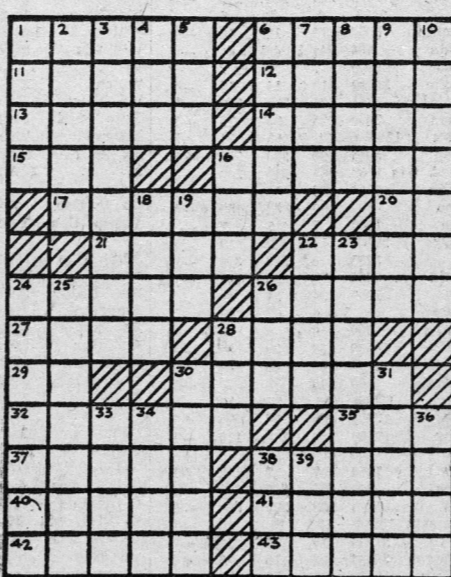
OTTAWA (CP) — A once-in-a-lifetime benefit conferred by the new federal budget will allow a husband to give his wife title to \$10,000 in the home they share without having to pay gift tax on the transfer.

Under the same provision in the budget presented to the Commons Tuesday night, a farmer can give his son or daughter a \$10,000 share in a farm to be operated by the child or the farmer and child together.

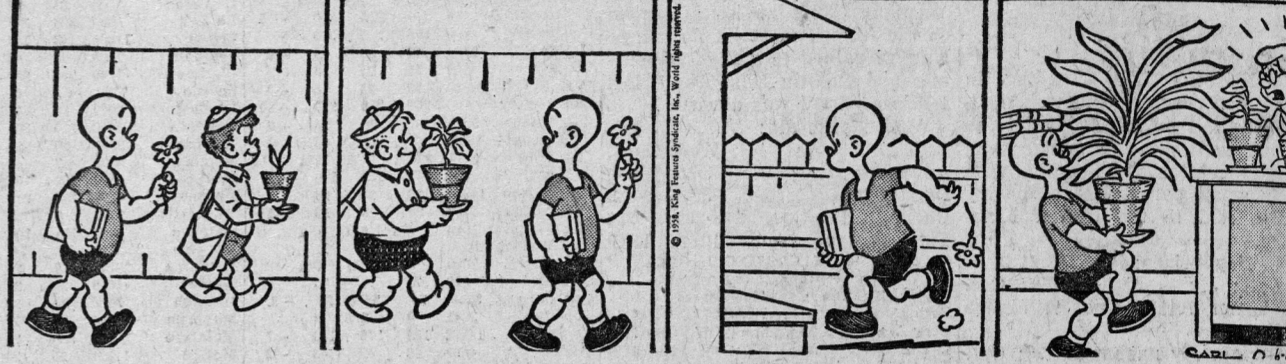
