MONTREAL, Sept. 20-(CP)-Receipts: 41 cattle, 108 sheep and lambs, 391 hogs and 164 calves for sale on the two Montreal livestock markets today, the Dominion Department of Agriculture reported. Cattle and lambs were steady. Calves and hogs easier. There were not enough cattle offered to make market. Prices of the few sold were in line with yesterday's quotation: Choice yearlings \$12.50 to \$13.50. Calves were easier. There were no tops. Medium to good calves in mixed lots brought \$9.50 with common light kinds from \$5.50 up. Grassers were \$4 to \$4.50. Good ewes and wethers were \$9 to \$9.25. Buck lambs were cut \$1 per cwt. and culled \$2 per cwt. Sheep were \$7.50 to \$4.50. Hogs were easier at \$9 for bacon fed and watered and \$9.25 off trucks. Selects drew \$1 per hog premium with the regular culls on off grades. Sows were \$8.50 to \$7.50. Rail grade hogs declined 30 cents to \$11.50 hot weight. Sows remained unchanged at \$5.80. Choice steers sold for \$7.25, good \$6.40, fair \$5.25, and common \$3.00 to \$4.25. Choice heifers were \$6.50, good \$5.75, medium \$5.50, fair \$4.25, and common \$3.00 to \$4.00. Good \$3.75, canners and cutters \$3.00 and butcher bulls \$3.00 to \$3.50 and butcher bulls \$3.50 to \$4.00. Veals \$3.50 to \$4.50, grassers \$3.50, choice lambs \$9.25.
