You're the only one who really knew me at all.

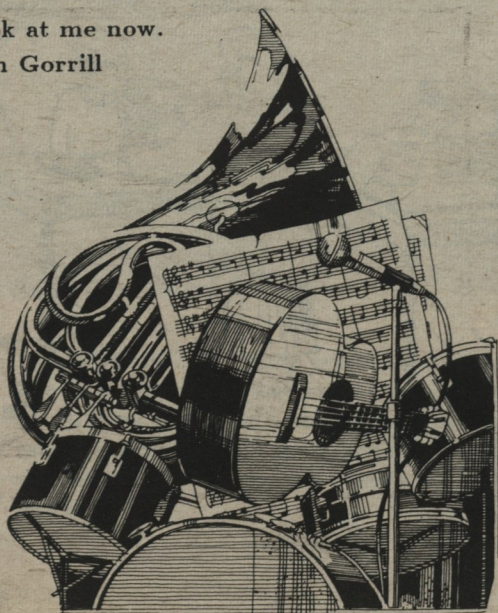
## Chorus

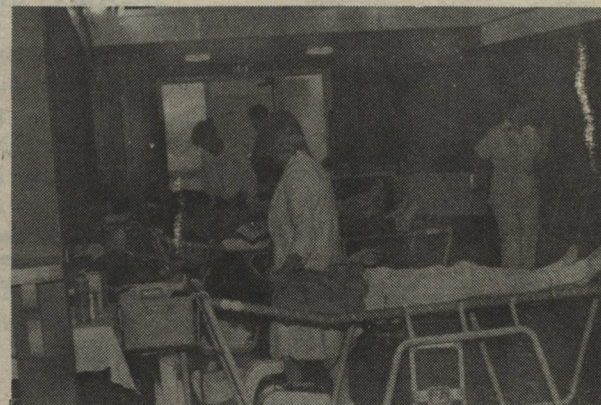
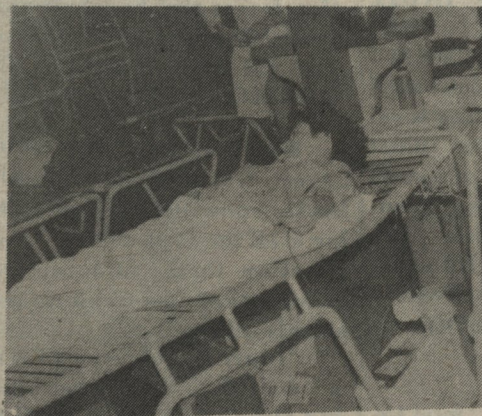
## UPEI Music Students Form Music Society
