Fair Distribution Of Grant Planned By P.E.I. Department

The department of physical education will proceed "slowly and cautiously" in distributing the \$60,000 physical fitness grant to be received this year from the national fitness fund, David Boswell, director of the department, said yesterday.

"A lot of sound thinking will be required on the allotment," Mr. Boswell said. "We intend to proceed slowly using every precaution to see that the grant is distributed fairly."

THREE COMPONENTS
He said the money, amounting to \$60,000, will be used to develop the three components of a comprehensive physical fitness program: (1) physical education in schools; (2) community recreation; (3) amateur sport.

Under the first heading, Mr. Boswell said he hopes some of the money will be used to better equip regional high schools to teach physical education. He said this could be done by further supplementing the budgets and salaries of present physical education specialists.

In addition, regular classroom teachers in schools, which have no physical education instructor, would be given the opportunity to improve their professional training in this field by attending summer schools and workshop through grants from the fund.

Mr. Boswell said he hopes more money will be available for track and field athletes who wish to improve themselves, and national competitors.

Part of the money will go toward assisting present agencies and organizations in promoting fitness and amateur sport programs.

Housing Official Blasts Councillor

"I am positively sure that Councillor Hyndman is doing everything in his power to see that the co-operative housing project will become another blighted area in Charlottetown," Al Belliveau, vice-chairman of the provincial Housing Commission, said yesterday.

He was commenting on Council E.E. Hyndman's opposition at Monday night's meeting of City Council to a resolution to have a portion of land from the co-operative housing development for \$11,115.

NO EXPLANATION?
Continuing his comments, Mr. Belliveau asked: "How can one explain his stand on the purchase by the city of the remainder of the co-operative housing development for \$11,115?"

When the co-op groups made representation to the city in the spring of 1961 for water and sewage services, they were assured by the city that if they built 60 homes in the area, these services would be provided.

"The groups then launched a massive membership campaign but could only come up with 54 members, which was six short of the 60 arrived at by the city. City council, at that time, would not alter its quota of 60 houses and the co-op groups were then forced by council to cut the number of homes from 75-foot frontage to 60-foot frontage.

WERE ASSURED
"With this the only alternative possible, the groups accepted it and were assured that the city would purchase the remainder of the property and develop the area into a playground."

"The price paid by the city for the remaining portion of this land is the same price per acre which was paid when the co-op purchased the property."
