SCIENTISTS PROPEL POSTS

To Avert Surprise Attacks. BELGRADE (AP) - Scientists at the Pugwash conference have proposed setting up observation posts on both sides of the Iron Curtain to detect any attempt at surprise attacks from East or West.

The conference has published a communiqué which has endorsed unanimously, suggesting army officers from the Western Bloc be stationed with Communist troops in East Europe. In turn, Communist officers would be stationed with troops in Western Europe.

Control posts in addition, the communiqué said should be set up in the chief transportation hubs of central Europe to keep an eye on movement of troops and vehicles as another measure for preventing surprise attack.

Eighty scientists, including 15 from the United States and 10 from the Soviet Union, attended the conference at the Yugoslav resort of Dubrovnik. The conference takes its name from Pugwash, N.S., where it was initially sponsored by Canadian-born Cyrus Eaton, a Cleveland industrialist. This was the 11th such conference.

Other points of the communiqué: 1. Governments of central Europe should enter negotiations leading to lessening of tension in that area and to the establishment of a demilitarized zone in central Europe.

2. Atom-free zones should be set up in the Balkans, Africa and Latin America. 3. Proposed sanctions against Cuba should be imposed on countries which build and test nuclear weapons after the treaty on banning of tests has been completed.

4. The International Atomic Energy Agency in Vienna should be authorized to control their use for manufacture of atomic weapons. The conference praised U.S. President Kennedy's proposal for increased co-operation between Eastern and Western countries in space and Soviet Foreign Minister Andrei Gromyko's suggestion of a pact prohibiting orbiting of nuclear weapons. It said both ideas originated in previous Pugwash conferences.
