CLEVELAND (AP)—If the weather outside is stormy and the field is slippery Sunday at Cleveland Stadium the National Football League's title game may turn into a field-goal duel between Cleveland Browns' Lou Groza and Baltimore Colts' Lou Michaels.

Strangely enough, both of the Cleveland coaches worked for Cleveland coach Blanton Collier. Michaels was a top-flight college tackle at Kentucky under Collier in 1957. Groza broke in with the old Cleveland Browns of the All-America Conference in 1946 when Collier was an assistant coach.

In fact, Don Shula, the Baltimore coach, also has a Collier connection. In addition to playing with the Browns in the early 1950s, Shula served as an assistant under Collier at Kentucky in 1959.

Groza is playing his 18th season of pro football. Age 40, he sports a bit of a paunch but that doesn't bother his kicking. Groza had a 567 percentage this year with 22 field goals in 33 attempts and a total of 115 points, a personal high. Except for a last-game spurt by Lenny Moore of the Colts, Groza would have been the league's scoring champ.

This has been a memorable year for Michaels who still holds the league record of 26 set in 1962, but made only 21 of 41 in 1963.

CANADA'S COACH SAYS

Australia Is Slipping As A Swimming Power.

VANCOUVER (CP)—Howard Kirby, the Alabama-born coach who took Canada's swimmers to the 1964 Olympic games, says Australia is slipping as a swimming power and it won't come.

"I believe the Aussies to be on the wane. But they may be able to come up with new blood by 1968."

Kirby, who fought paralytic polio in a Regina hospital to become a top coach, said in an interview he believes Canada could win one-quarter of the gold medals available to swimmers at the 1968 British Empire Games in Jamaica.

Many Canadians were content on building strength within their own swimming clubs to care about branching into international competition.

He picks Vancouver's Jane Hughes and Ron Jacks, Sandy Gilchrist of Ocean Falls, B.C., and Don Sherry of Toronto to shine for Canada in the 1968 Olympics.

"Now is the time Canada must do all it can for its young swimmers. We cannot afford to let these youngsters sit down and admire their scrapbooks. They've got a long way to go."

A step in the right direction, Kirby said, is the Canadian Amateur Swimming Association plan to send a team of about 30 to Europe next summer. Details are still tentative but proposed are trips to Spain, Portugal, France, Italy, Germany, the Netherlands and Britain.

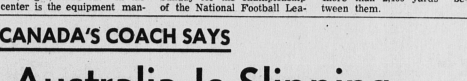

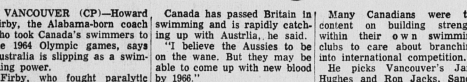
