Speaker Uses YMCA As Topic

SUMMERSIDE — At the weekly meeting of the Y's Men on Thursday night, guest speaker Austin Blanford gave an address on "the meaning of the YMCA, the Y's Men's organization and their relationship." Mr. Blanford is the international director for the Maritime region and was paying a scheduled visit to Summerside.

In his talk, Mr. Blanford traced the history of the YMCA from its beginning and explained the "close relationship which exists between it and the Y's Men's movement, which over 44 years ago consisted of only 17 clubs. There are now this many club's in the Maritime Provinces alone, and, with the recent formation of a club in Finland, the movement has grown to 78 clubs in 45 nations. He explained that membership, active, enthusiastic membership, was the lifeblood of the movement and urged every member to make a concentrated effort to bring in new members. Mr. Blanford was introduced by Eric Jones and thanked by Ross MacKenzie.
