1. Item Number one was, Steering Committee, which had been set up to look into, and decide, direction of Student Council..Chris Campaigne, Alan Landry and Carline Hill presented their ideas,(outline below). Motion to accept report, discussion about Library Committee, decided to omit the committee, motion seconded and carried.

2. Derek brought up contract concerning Day Care Centre. He explained terms of contract and position S.U. was left in. After discussion, it was unanimously decided to approach John Carr, to look into validity of contract.

6. Atlantic Federation of Students: Derek and Paul are going to the one-day convention in Sackville on Nov.27. It has to be decided if we are going to join the A.F.S. and it is hoped that some decision can be made following the conference.

7. Matter of Winter Carnival, chairpersons, was next on agenda but meeting came to an end because quorum was lost.

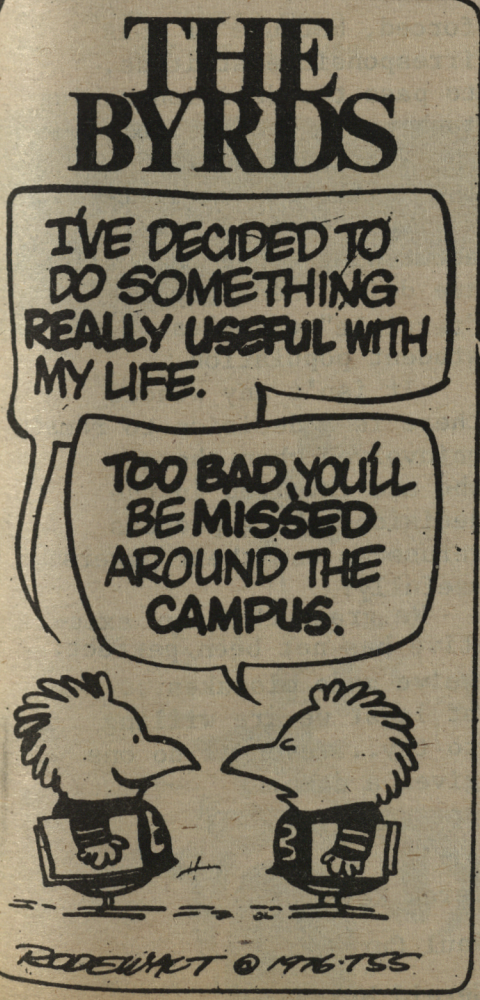
