(2) and in February (2).

- d) One (1) S.U. representative to Board of Governors, elected to Council in September
- e) nine (9) elected representatives for students in the faculties according to the proportion of students each faculty has in the total enrollment, as shown by enrollment figures one month before the student election in February, to be specified by the Electoral Committee.

## ARTICLE VIII- OFFICERS AND EXECUTIVE

1. The offices of the UPEISU shall be:
  - a) President
  - b) Vice-President
  - c) Treasurer
  - d) Comptroller
2. Each executive officer will hold a seat on Council and have one vote.

## ARTICLE LX - POWERS AND DUTIES OF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS

1. The President shall:
  - a) be the chief executive of the union
  - b) be official spokesman of the union
  - c) call all meetings of the union (council, general, executive, annual, emergency etc.)
  - d) be responsible for the direction and integration of all activities.
  - e) be a member of the University Senate
  - f) preside over all meetings of the General Assembly and Executive or ask the Speaker to do so in his absence.
  - g) be bound to call a council meeting within 48 hours of receiving a petition signed by 5% of the student body or 2/3 majority in Council requesting such a meeting.
  - h) to publish the agenda at least 48 hours before a meeting and to have it include any material pertinent to articles in the agenda.
  - i) call executive meetings prior to regular Council meetings.
  - j) issue a "state of the Union address" within 30 days prior to termination of office.
  - k) carry out resolutions of Council when applicable
  - l) appoint advisory committees to study topics which Council considers pertinent.
  - m) the President shall present a report of specific aims, goals and objectives, as put forth by the executive, to the first Council meeting in October
  - n) perform other duties as required.
  - o) in the event of a tie vote in an Executive meeting, the President shall take the matter at issue to the Council for a decision

- p) be responsible for community, provincial national and international organizations, and be responsible for the appropriate committees.
  - Q) be a co-signing authority on all cheques.
2. THE VICE-PRESIDENT SHALL:
    - a) be responsible for the co-ordination of the activities of the union's sub-organizations, and be responsible for them to Council.
    - b) be a member of the Senate.
    - c) assume the duties of the President according to the terms of article 25 section 3 in such times as the President resigns, is impeached or is absent.
    - d) be responsible for the operation of the UPEISU Newspaper.
    - e) be a co-signing authority on all cheques.
    - f) perform other duties as required.
  3. THE TREASURER SHALL:
    - a) be a member of the Board of Governors and be the student representative on the financial committee and the building and grounds committee.
    - b) be responsible for the financial administration of all union funds.
    - c) the Treasurer shall select a committee to be approved by Council which will be the financial committee of which shall advise the Treasurer on financial matters.
    - d) submit on request a financial statement of union funds and submit reports at the last meeting prior to the end of first and second semester.
    - e) submit the results of the yearly audit at the first Council meeting of the Fall.
    - f) the Treasurer shall present a yearly budget by the end of September.
    - g) permit students to have access to the financial records of the union within 24 hours of request, properly posted.
    - h) keep regular business hours not less than 10 hours per week and not less than 1 hour per day.
    - i) insure that a clear and accurate account of all financial transactions of the union be kept
    - j) to assume the responsibility of external advertising
    - k) be responsible for the disbursement of funds under the following conditions:
      - 1) by a co-signing authority on all cheques
      - 2) be the co-signing authority on all cheques exceeding five hundred (500) dollars.
      - 3) authorize all expenditures in writing.
      - 4) approve all payroll.
      - 5) insure that all cheques be issued by the Business Manager
      - 6) in the event of changes to the above regulations, it would require approval of Council.
    - l) perform other duties as required.
