tempted. The combined high card point count in the North-South hands was 28 points. The missing 12 points, in view of the opening spade bid, were likely to be with East. If this was true, ordinary means would not make the contract.

South embarked on a farsighted campaign to make the hand. Instead of trying the two diamond finesses which appeared doomed to failure, he abandoned them both.

First he ran his remaining four trumps, discarding the ten of diamonds from dummy. Next he cashed three rounds of clubs, ending in dummy with the king.

In his own hand South had left his original three diamonds. In dummy remained the eight of spades and the A-Q of diamonds. East had to bare down to the ten of spades and the K-J of diamonds. West might just as well have gone to the movies.

The eight of spades was led and East had to win it. It was his third trick, but it was the end of the trail. He had to lead from his K-J of diamonds into dummy's A-Q.

The lesson to be learned from South's well-executed plan is his early recognition of the futility of taking two diamond finesses. Once this realistic appraisal was made, other means had to be sought. That South found the solution is a tribute to his perspicacity. It is not easy so early in the play to visualize the three-card end position.

**Report Egyptians Break Cease Fire With Machinegun Attack**

PORT SAID, Egypt (Reuters)—A British Army communiqué Sunday night reported that Egyptian troops in the Suez Canal Zone had broken the cease fire with a machinegun attack on Anglo-French positions. The British did not reply to the fire.

**Cuba Seeks Resolution On Hungary**

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (CP)—Cuba sought Sunday to get an overwhelming majority of the 79 United Nations on record against Soviet deportation of Hungarians.

It changed its pending resolution to meet objections from other delegations and win more votes in the General Assembly.

A delegate who has sounded out the general sentiment predicted the proposal will pass easily over Soviet and Hungarian opposition.

Russia and the present Hungarian Communist regime insist the assembly has no right to discuss the situation in Hungary, where Soviet troops were used to crush a revolution. Budapest radio declared Sunday that nobody has been deported from Hungary.

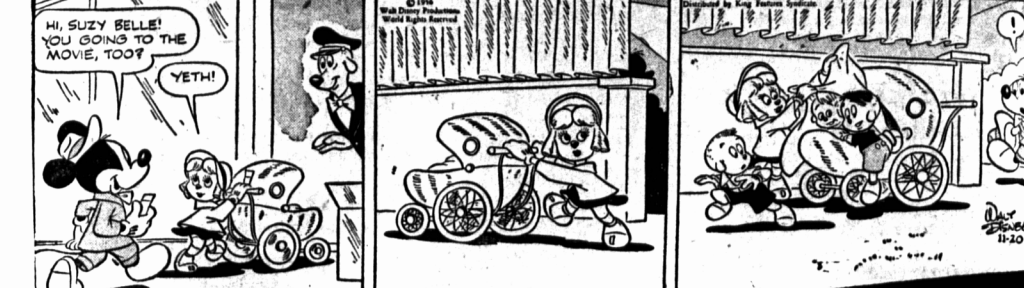

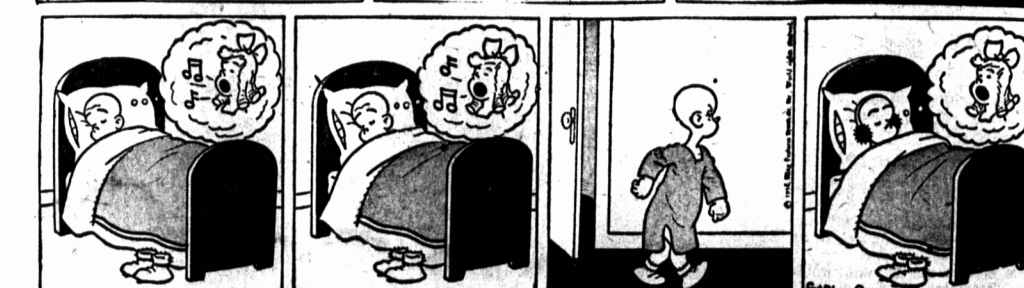
