FACTS FOR FARMERS



Warble Flies Costly, Let's Eliminate Them

The time has arrived when the final phase of the Warble Fly Campaign is to take place. All cattle owners in the province are advised to check the backs of their cattle and if warble grubs are present the following procedure should be followed:

1. Make a note of the number and size of cattle with warbles. Also note whether cattle are milking, dry, when to calve, etc.
2. Procure the necessary chemical to treat your cattle from the contact man in your area and use the chemical according to directions. The contact man will have available two chemicals:
 - (1) Rotenone powder: for use on animals from which milk or meat will be used for human consumption within 30 days after treatment. This is only effective on warble fly lumps that have started to open. The scab must be removed and a paste (made with rotenone powder and water) applied directly on the hole in the lump. Because the warble lumps do not all open at the same time it may be necessary to treat two or three times with rotenone treatment when there are several warbles on cattle.
 - (2) Ruelene: for use on all animals except those producing milk or meat for human use within 30 days after treatment. This chemical is mixed one part Ruelene to three parts of water and the mixture applied as a pour-on-treatment at the rate of one oz. per 100 lbs. live weight of the animal, but not to exceed eight oz. on any animal. One treatment is sufficient to kill the Warble grubs with this chemical.

Warble flies cause much economic loss to cattle owners. They frighten and chase cattle and develop as parasites in the animal body from September or October until emergence the next April, May or June. Warble infections make holes in hides and cut down their value. They also cause extra trimming and loss on carcasses affected. The only way that warble flies can overwinter is in the body of animals. Warble flies do not fly more than a few thousand feet. As an island we should not tolerate this expensive animal parasite. If everyone co-operates and remains vigilant we can eliminate this pest from Prince Edward Island and maintain this province as a warble fly free area.

If all cattle owners check all of their cattle and all warble grubs are killed before emergence this spring, then we will be rid of this costly pest. Please co-operate by making sure that no warble grubs escape from your cattle to infest the herds in your area this spring.

P.S. All areas east of Portage are organized on a school district basis with a contact man in each district. The contact man has the chemicals to use. You should get these from him if you find warbles on your cattle. For farmers west of Portage the chemicals are available at most farm supply stores.

A few points in the new policy are:

(a) Applies to boars of breeding age. This is usually six months of age or more and was also a clause in the old policy.

(b) Bonus is paid only on boars of test litter or identical breeding as test litter by a subsequent mating. In looking over scores of litters from the same dam with different sires it became evident that this clause was necessary to ensure at least some improvement in our swine.

(c) The old policy applied to only one class of boar. The new policy applies broadly to two classes: (1) Percentage yield over 79.0; (2) Percentage yield 78.6 to 79.0. Also additional premiums will apply to boars from sows whose litter had a feed conversion of not more than 320 lbs. of feed per 100 lbs. live gain or either sire or dam graded very good or better in type classification.

(d) As in the old policy there is an initial bonus payable at time of application and inspection and an annual smaller bonus paid as long as the boar is kept as a breeder. The initial bonus applies only once on any given boar, even though he is resold as a breeder.

EFFECTIVE DATE

Because some boars already started may not have the basic qualifications as to ROP RE requirements, this policy will be effective starting Sept. 1, 1966.

1. 1966 BLYCIVLINGQUIR

The boar bonus policy of the P.E.I. Department of Agriculture is one that has been used quite widely by farmers of the province. The use of bonused boars is credited with having done much to improve and maintain hog quality in the province over the years. The boar has 50 percent influence on all progeny. The use of a high class boar certainly is essential to improve hog quality. The ROP RE system takes into account the economic value of the carcass. Feed conversion figures and days to market are also recorded for the use of the purebred breeder and purchaser of breeding stock. The commercial sow breeder should always be rigid in his selection of replacement sows and should use males that are at least of a class eligible for bonus under the Boar Bonus Policy.

Purchasers of Registered boars whose date per centage yield is over 79.00 will be bonused \$40 at purchase and application, and \$20 annually as long as the boar is kept for a breeder. If the percentage yield figure is 78.60 to 79.00 these payments will be \$30 initially and \$15 annually.

Five dollars additional will be paid annually after purchase on boars from sow with a feed conversion of 320 lbs. or less per 100 lbs. live weight gain OR either sire or dam be graded "very good" or better.

This additional amount will be \$10 annually after purchase if both above options are fulfilled.

USE BETTER BORE

Last year there were almost 200 boars bonused by the P.E.I. Department of Agriculture. It is estimated that there are about 200 other boars in use in this province. Why not improve your swine herd by using a better boar? He may cost you a few extra dollars at time of purchase but with the boar bonus policy assistance he should be a very good investment for you. Boars of Yorkshire, Landrace and Large comb breeding are available in this province that are eligible

for bonus by the P.E.I. Department of Agriculture. When you anticipate needing a new boar in the near future it is a good idea to speak ahead a month or more either to a purebred breeder of your acquaintance or to someone from the Department of Agriculture.

BOAR BONUS POLICY REVISED

Starting in 1965 a new system for ROP testing of swine has been carried out in Canada. This new system takes into account total fat, loin area, ham area and percentage of lean, length and weight; and by using certain factors ends up with a figure which is the percentage yield of trimmed cuts in the carcass. This system is considerably more accurate than the old scoring system in evaluating the true value of the carcass from the standpoint of its economic worth.

Because our old boar bonus policy was based on the old ROP system which is no longer in effect we found it necessary to revise our policy. At the time of revision it also seemed a good opportunity to make a few necessary additions to the policy.

IS NAMED PREMIER

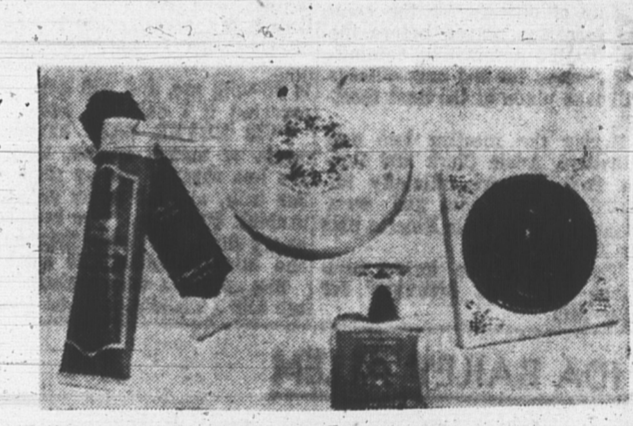
