New York Stocks

NEW YORK (AP) - The stock market advanced Wednesday, but the burden of the rise rested on the railroads.

The rails forged into high ground, and the rest of the market went right along with them. Near the close, profit-taking appeared, but the railroads stoutly resisted the sell-off.

Most major divisions were a mixture of gains and losses with the plus signs usually holding a slight edge.

The Associated Press average of 60 stock was up 90 cents at \$172.50, the 10th record high score in the last 13 sessions.

Canadian issues were mostly higher. Canadian Pacific, Dome Mines and McIntyre all added 1/4.

Hiram Walker and Distillers Seagram both gained 1/4 while International Nickel slipped 1/4.

On the American stock exchange Lake Shore and Giant Yellow-knife both lost 1/4.
