When asked what the new name would be, Green became secretive. "The first issue will just be called the Student Union Newspaper or the SUN. The new name will not be revealed until next week.


He would only elaborate further on this by saying it was "a quotation".

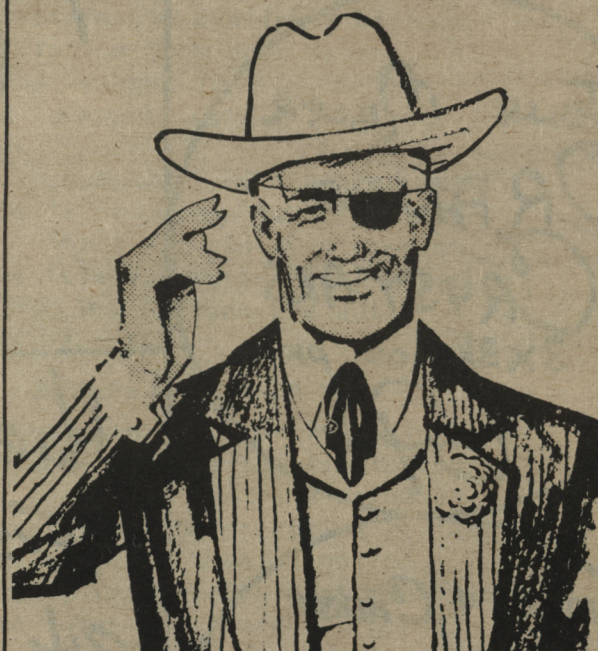
