WINNIPEG, July 30 (CP) — Commercial demand for oats and barley on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange today was on a less aggressive scale. However, there was some buying in barley by exporters and U.S. milling interests. Trade reports indicated small amounts of barley had been sold to the continent overnight. Oats received some support from American shippers. Prices of oats and barley futures were fairly steady. The rye trade saw an increase in hedging sales with some U.S. demand shown. Flax brought some industrial and export purchases. Trading was moderately active. Overnight loadings of Canadian wheat for export were: United Kingdom, 1,400,000 bushels, India 690,000, Peru 530,000, Switzerland 415,000, Yugoslavia 350,000 and Germany 310,000.
