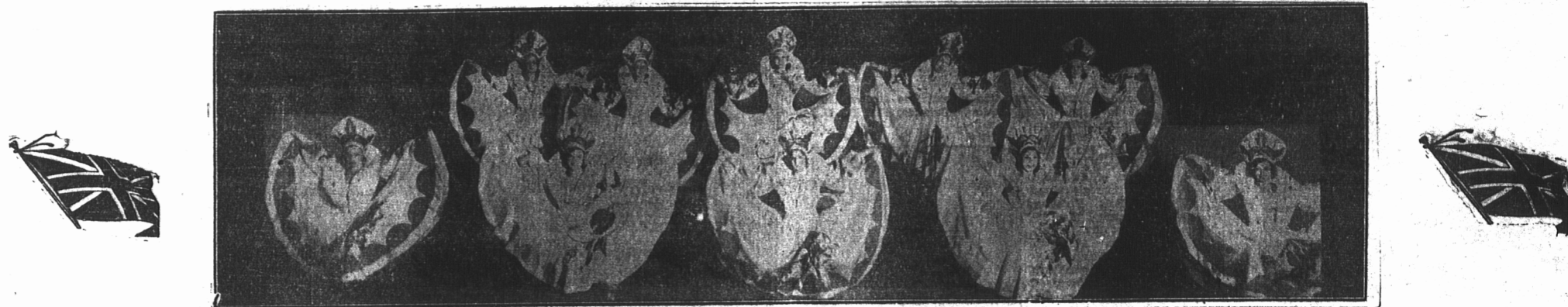

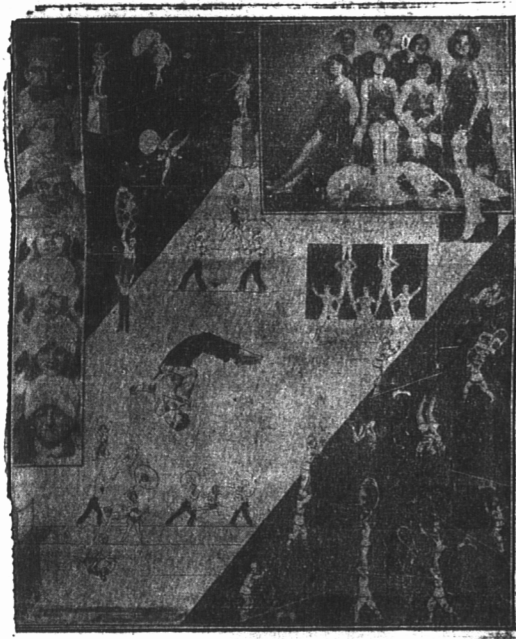

Ten young glamorous dancing girls in gorgeously costumed ballets and elaborate dance numbers.



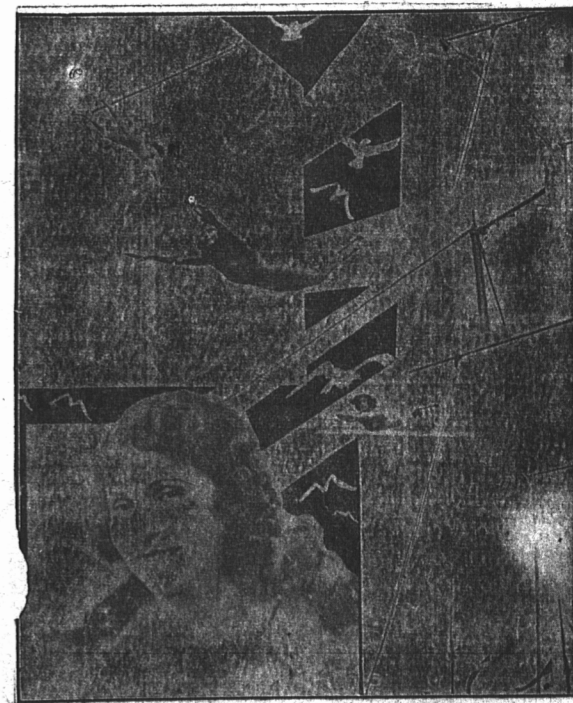
THE AVALON TROUPE

Double tight-wire act from South Africa, and The Romanoffs, thrilling acrobatic and teeter-board novelty.



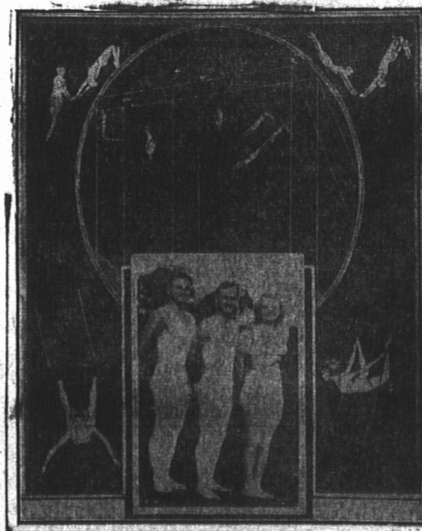
SNIDER'S BEARS

Animal sense and nonsense in clever and unbelievable tricks.



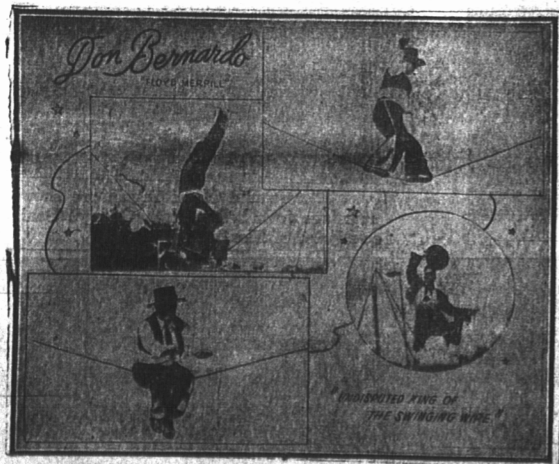
WINNIFRED THE GASP GIRL

In their famous flying trapeze act. See their sensational mid-air somersaults.

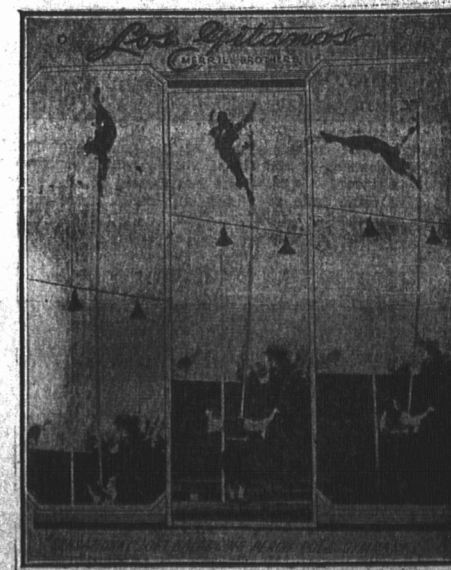


DON BERNARDO
