

Christmas Scene Atop Local Hall

The Teena Liguorian Club of Holy Redeemer parish saw one of their projects brought to a successful issue last evening when the lights were turned on to show in detail the adoration scene they built and placed in position atop the Community Centre.

The production is 24 ft long and 14 ft high and was started by the young people early in August with a view to having it ready for placing before Christmas as a gesture towards placing "Christ back in Christmas," and as a contribution to the opening days of the Charlottetown Centennial year. The scene is illuminated by 26 moderate, candlepower lights, four 150 candlepower spot lights and six flood lights of 200 C.P. each.
