Indian Ends Fast After 73 Days

HURON VILLAGE, Que., May 5 (CP) — Weak and growing confused after a 73-day diet of nothing but sweetened water, Jules Siouli today gave up his hunger-strike as a means of winning recognition of rights he claims for the Indians.

News of the end of the 43-year-old Huron's fast, started Feb. 22, was given out by Dr. Gaston Jean, medical officer at this Indian reservation, after a morning visit to Siouli's bedside.

The young doctor, who has called every two days at the asphalt-shingled house combining the Indian's home, grocery store and barber shop, said Siouli broke his hunger-strike by sipping a cup of tea.

He described Siouli as satisfied with his decision to start eating again and said Siouli planned to employ other means to awaken public opinion to the situation of the Indians under white rule.

Dr. Jean said he recommended that Siouli postpone until he is stronger a statement he wishes to make explaining why he stopped his fast and how he proposes to continue his campaign for Indian independence and self-government.

The doctor said Siouli will have to stay on a liquid diet for some days because of the length of time he has been without solid food, and will gradually be brought back to a normal diet.

While his hunger-strike lasted, Siouli's weight fell from 170 to 112 pounds.

Four Frenchmen Executed For Treason

PARIS, May 5 — (AP) — A firing squad today executed four French traitors. One of them, jauntily wearing a rose in his lapel, asked the riflemen not to shoot him in the head because he was bequeathing his eyes to a Paris hospital. The firing squad obeyed his request. A French physician removed the eyes and said they would be used in an operation on a blind man now in the hospital. All were condemned for being members of an infamous "French Gestapo" which arrested and tortured Frenchmen for the Germans during the Nazi occupation of Paris.

British Trawler Seized By Reds

GRIMSBY, Lincolnshire, England, May 6 — (AP) — Owners of a British trawler said today that the vessel has been boarded by Russians in the vicinity of the Scandinavian peninsula and taken to Murmansk.

The trawler is the Etruria, which left Grimsby April 19 bound for the White Sea. It is owned by the Standard Steam Fishing Company.

A company spokesman said the seizure occurred Monday. Another trawler picked up a radio message from the Etruria saying she was being taken over by a Russian crew. The second trawler relayed the word to Grimsby.

The Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries said it has confirmed that the vessel was seized, but gave no indication as to what action will be taken.

Such "arrests" of fishing boats by the Russians have been increasingly frequent in recent months, with Scandinavian and German vessels mainly concerned. It has been attributed to strict security measures to cover up defence works along the Soviet Union's Arctic and Baltic coasts.

In most cases both boats and crews ultimately have been released.

Cabinet Ministers Pensions Approved

HALIFAX, May 6 — (CP) — By a split vote along party lines the Nova Scotia Legislature today approved a bill to grant pensions to cabinet ministers.

Robert Stanfield, Progressive Conservative Opposition leader and C. C. F. chief Russell Cunningham opposed the measure. The debate came while the House was in committee. It passed committee by a straight party vote — Progressive Conservatives and C. C. F. opposing.

The proposed legislation would give a minimum pension of \$4,500 and a maximum of \$6,300 for the premier. A minister of 60 years after 10 years service would be entitled to \$4,000 with a maximum of not more than \$6,000 a year.

Safebreakers Get \$200 At Saint John

SAINT JOHN, N. B., May 5 — (CP) — Safebreakers who escaped with about \$200 last night remained at large tonight. The theft was discovered early today after a 800-pound safe had been moved from the office of Dwight Magee, Ltd., clothing manufacturers on the ground floor of the Cornwall and York Cotton Mills building on Albion Street.

The safe was opened with an axe outside the building. Stamps, cheques for \$3,000, a smashed cash box and two suits owned by Mr. Magee were found nearby.

Chief of Clan MacLean To Attend N. S. Mod

SYDNEY, N. S., May 6 — (CP) — Sir Charles Hector Fitzroy MacLean, world chief of the Scottish Clan MacLean, will arrive here Aug. 8 to attend the annual Gaelic Mod—or gathering—at St. Ann's. About 1,000 clansmen are expected at the airport to meet the chieftain from Duart Castle on the rocky isle of Mull on his arrival.

Plan To Celebrate "Newfoundland Day"

OTTAWA, May 6 — (CP) — Plans are under way for the celebration of a special "Newfoundland Day" June 24.

The event will be marked by special observances by a number of national organizations which have or are establishing branches in the new Canadian province.

The celebration will include a special air show at Torbay airport, St. John's, Newfoundland, and it is expected that both the Royal Canadian Air Force and the Fleet Air Arm of the Royal Canadian Navy will take part.

A committee of St. John's business men headed by Sqdn. Ldr. A. C. Holmes is in charge of arrangements for the celebration. A Mainland group, to be known as the "Newfoundland Day" inter-provincial co-ordinating committee, will assist the local committee.

This committee is made up of representatives of national organizations who have an interest in the celebration and each of whom will co-ordinate the activities of the various branches of his own organization across Canada in connection with "Newfoundland Day".

Er. R. McFarland of Lethbridge, Alta., vice-president of the Royal Canadian Flying Clubs Association and national councillor Canadian Chamber of Commerce, has been appointed chairman, and M. A. Eymour, K. C., of St. Catharines, Ont. is vice-president.

Other members of the committee are George M. Ross, Ottawa, Air Cadet League of Canada; T. D. Anderson, Ottawa, Canadian Legion; Sqdn. Ldr. J. H. Giguere, Ottawa, Royal Canadian Air Force Association; Roy McInnes, Montreal, Trans-Canada Air Lines; Col. W. W. Murray, Ottawa, Newfoundland Memorial University Extension Fund; G. W. M. Grant, Ottawa National Film Board; Charles P. Wright, Ottawa, Canadian Broadcasting Corp., and D. L. Buchanan, Ottawa, Royal Flying Clubs Association.

The committee will be enlarged as the names of representatives of additional Canada-wide organizations are added.
