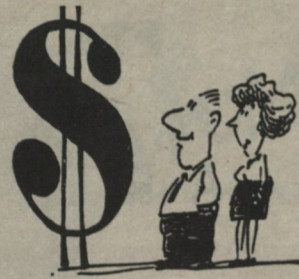

Memorial Bursary Fund For Students With Disabilities

To be eligible for this bursary, a student must:

- (1) Be in financial need.
- (2) Be registered as a full-time student at UPEI.
- (3) Submit a letter describing the disability.
- (4) Have a letter of recommendation written in light of your disability.

Application forms may be picked up at the Registrar's Office. Applications and documents are to be submitted to the Registrar's Office by February 9th, 1996.
