Breakwater At North Lake To Be Extended In Spring

OTTAWA. - (Special) - Extension of the breakwater at North Lake, King's County, will be carried out by the federal government this year. John A. Macdonald, Conservative MP for Kings, disclosed Thursday.

Estimated cost of the project would be between \$20,000 and \$30,000.

The public works department has called tenders for the extension which will close Feb. 25. Work will start this spring. Mr. Macdonald said this project is an extension of the west side in an effort to minimize sand and silt drifting into the run due to prevailing westerly and northwesterly winds. North Lake Harbor is one of the busiest fishing harbors in Prince Edward Island.

The construction of the boat slips and other extensions on each side now nearing completion will add greatly to the improvement of accommodations there.

"A new automatic range light will be installed before the beginning of the fishing season," Mr. Macdonald added that it was hoped this extension would be effective in reducing the amount of dredging required to keep the harbor from silting to any great extent.
