Retired Ch'town Business Man Dies At 78 Years

A former director of the now defunct Charlottetown Selling Agencies, Ltd., E. Bruce Huggan, died Thursday morning at the Livingstone-MacArthur nursing home following a lengthy illness. He was 78 years of age.

Born in Moncton, the son of the late William T. Huggan of Halifax and the late Sarah Weldon of Moncton, Mr. Huggan came to Charlottetown with his parents at an early age. His father was the District Passenger agent for the C.N.R. for many years.

He was married to the former Gertrude Boyer of Charlottetown who predeceased him. They did not have any children.

Mr. Huggan was educated in Charlottetown and later became connected with the local selling agency. Prior to his retirement in 1957, he was connected with the firm of Moore and MacLeod for nearly a quarter of a century.

A sister Dorothy (Mrs. J.J. Davies) is the lone survivor of his immediate family. Other survivors include two nephews and two nieces.

The remains will rest at MacLean's Funeral Home from where funeral services will be held on Saturday afternoon at two o'clock. Interment will be in the People's Cemetery.
