DEVON, Alta. — (CP) — Regular instructions in first-aid methods are being given workers in the Devon Oil Field, scene of several accidents in recent weeks.

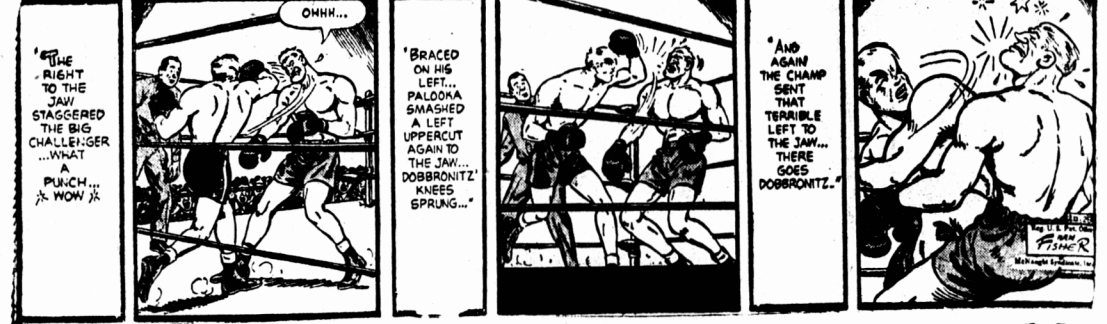

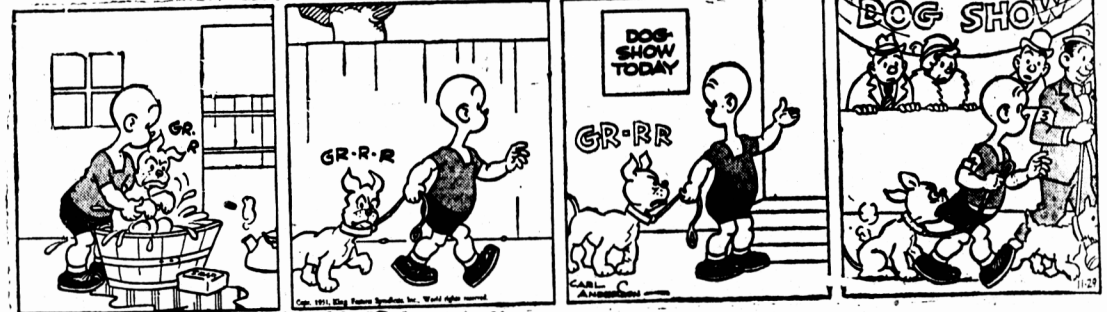
