September - April. The coordinator position will require that the applicant be able to give a minimum of 3-5 hours per week to the project.

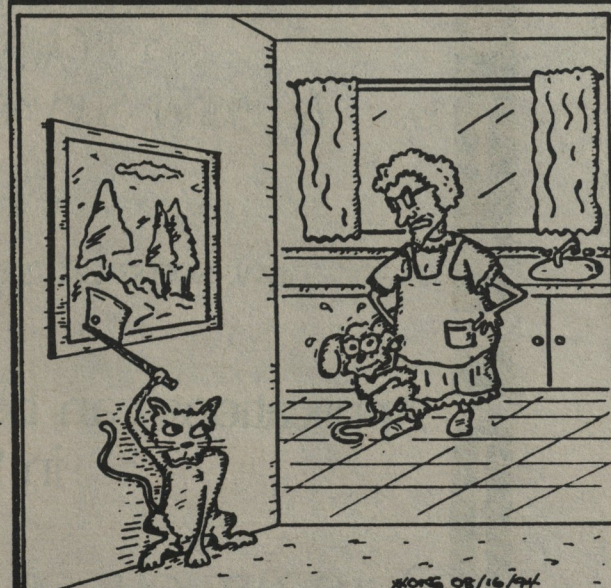
Honorarium
