His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor, by request of Mr. Farquharson, distributed the School Board Certificates to the most proficient scholars, and delivered a short address. After complimenting the school upon the excellence exhibited in the examinations, His Honor said that he had not noticed, in the course of his visits to the schools, that the children were examined in the geography and history of their own country.

He had, however, noticed that the teaching in the minor branches was very thorough. The essays that he had heard read, were of a high order of merit, showing that the pupils had a good grounding in English. He enlarged upon the importance of being able to speak and write the English language correctly and knowing all about our own country.

In conclusion, he suggested that His Excellency the Governor-General could not, upon his arrival here this year, be greeted by a more beautiful or more pleasing sight than all the school children of the town massed upon Queen Square, in the midst of the flower garden.

Mr. T. C. James said that he had attended the examinations of this school for several years, and he had noted an improvement year by year. He thought that improvement was more noticeable in this school than in the others. The children were, as had been remarked by the Lieutenant-Governor and Hon. Mr. Laird, thoroughly grounded.

As to a knowledge of their own country, he had examined a class, beginning at Cape Breton and going west to the western borders of Ontario, with the result that the pupils finally got ahead of him. In all the schools he had found that instruction in our own country had a very prominent place.

Mr. Farquharson said that Queen Square School had been very satisfactory to the school board in the past term. He claimed a little credit for the Board. They had appointed a Supervisor who had been able to see and correct things that were going wrong in the schools. He congratulated Mr. Stewart upon the work which he had done as Supervisor and Grading Officer.
