Household Hints.

Substitute for Eggs.—Doughnuts made without eggs, and with a tablespoonful of corn starch in place of each egg is a novelty, and is thought well of by some cooks.

Buckwheat Cakes.—A little cider if added to buckwheat batter will make the cakes brown nicely and help to form a sort of crust on the outside.

Useful Pomade.—The Union Medicale gives the formula of Lasague & Regnaud's valuable pomade as follows: Chloroform twenty parts, and vaseline sixty parts.

Washing Blue Fabrics.—Articles of a delicate blue that must be washed are often ruined in the process; this may be avoided by adding an ounce of sugar of lead to a pailful of water, and letting the article lie in this for an hour and a half or even for two hours.

Cure for Frost Bites.—Now that winter is here, I deem it a duty to humanity to publish a cure for frost bites. I have used it many times with complete success.

To Make Celery Crisp.—Celery that is not so crisp as it should be, may be eaten prepared like this: After washing the celery and removing the green leaves, cut in pieces about as you do asparagus, then put it into boiling water that is salted; when it is tender drain it, lay it on slices of buttered toast, which you have just dipped in the

water in which you cooked the celery; add butter, pepper, and salt to your taste; serve hot.

Excellent Starch.—Starch which will not stick in white patches on your dark cambric dress, is made thus: Take the very best fine starch you can get, mix in the proportion of two table-spoonfuls to six little water as will make a smooth paste, and to this add a pint of clear coffee, let it boil for ten minutes.
