INSPECTION OF MEAT IS STRICT

WASHINGTON, Sept. 20.—Further rulings in connection with the enforcement of the meat inspection law, after Oct. 1 next were made public today by Secretary of Agriculture, and give an idea of what consumers are to expect hereafter when purchasing meat products, particularly canned goods.

Any thing saved or descriptive name will not be used, and no picture, design or device which gives any false indication of origin or quality will be permitted upon any label, as for example, the picture of a pig appearing on a label placed upon beef products or the picture of a chicken upon the label of a veal or pork product. Geographical names are allowed to be used only with the words "type," "brand" or "style" as the case may be except upon foods produced or manufactured in the place, state, territory or country named.

For instance, "Virginia ham" must be marked "Virginia style ham," "English brawn," "English style brawn," "Westphalia ham," must be "Westphalia style ham." The word "ham" without a prefix indicating the species of animal, is considered by the department to be a pork ham, but trimmings removed from the ham and used in the preparation of potted meats or sausages, or when used alone, may be known as "potted ham" or ham sausage.

Frankfurter sausage no longer can be known as such, but meats be called "Frankfurter style sausage". The rules clearly define what constitutes pure lard but prescribe that a substance composed of lard, stearin or other animal fat and vegetable oil may be labelled "lard compound".

Among the restrictions are the following: "Pienic hams" cannot be called "hams but may be called "pienic" or "pienic shoulders".

"Little pig sausage" may be called "little pork sausage" or "pork sausage". Extract of beef must be actually made from beef, and veal loaf cannot be called such unless the meat used is veal only.

The same rules apply to other canned products and manufacturers are warned that the rulings do not exempt them from the enforcement of state laws.

DEADLY X-RAY THROUGH HEART

PHILADELPHIA, Sept. 20.—While undergoing an X-ray examination at the Polytechnic Hospital yesterday, Martin E. Murphy, a Renova, Pa. banker, one of the richest men in the State, died as though stricken by lightning.

Mr. Murphy passed a rigid physical examination before going into the chair and his heart action was pronounced perfect. Surgeons believe some unknown quality entered the ray and killing him. The examination was made to determine whether Mr. Murphy was afflicted with cancer.

The ray entered the throat on the left side, two inches below the ear, and penetrated diagonally down and through the chest to a point of emergency below the eighth rib. The course of the ray was through the heart.

As it flashed upon Mr. Murphy he stiffened strangely. The ray was turned off and it was found that he was stone dead. The body will be examined in the presence of some of the leading surgeons of the E. B. when it is hoped the real character of the death ray will be revealed.

CANADA'S WEALTH IN FAR NORTH

WASHINGTON, D. C. Sept. 21.—Consul Gabriel He Rivaland, of Dawson City, furnishes an interesting report on the fur trade of Northern Canada. He believes there is no immediate danger of fur-bearing animals being exterminated, and declares that there are vast unexplored regions in which fur-bearing animals abound.

He writes: "Inasmuch as Northern Canada is frequently neglected, the last great fur-bearing period, it is worth while to study the character of the supply in these districts. Its permanency as well as the number and proportion of the skins obtained.

Complete statistics are not available. However some light is thrown upon the subject by a table purporting to show the annual catches of the Hudson Bay Company. Large quantities of furs reach the market through other channels. For more than two centuries the fur trade has been vigorously prosecuted in Northern Canada, and yet the supply, save in the case of two or three varieties of animals, shows no formidable signs of exhaustion.

The buffalo, whose hide was once an important article in commerce, has disappeared before the advance of civilization. The beaver can apparently only be saved from a similar fate by extra-ordinary measures of protection. So, too, the fur seal of the islands and waters of the Pacific. The sea otter and the silver fox have been rare for many years.

For buyers seem to agree that fur-bearing animals of the North, with the exception of those noted, are not playing out. Vast extents of territory still almost approximately virgin and unexplored exist and the Indians are proving surprisingly careful in preserving game.
